

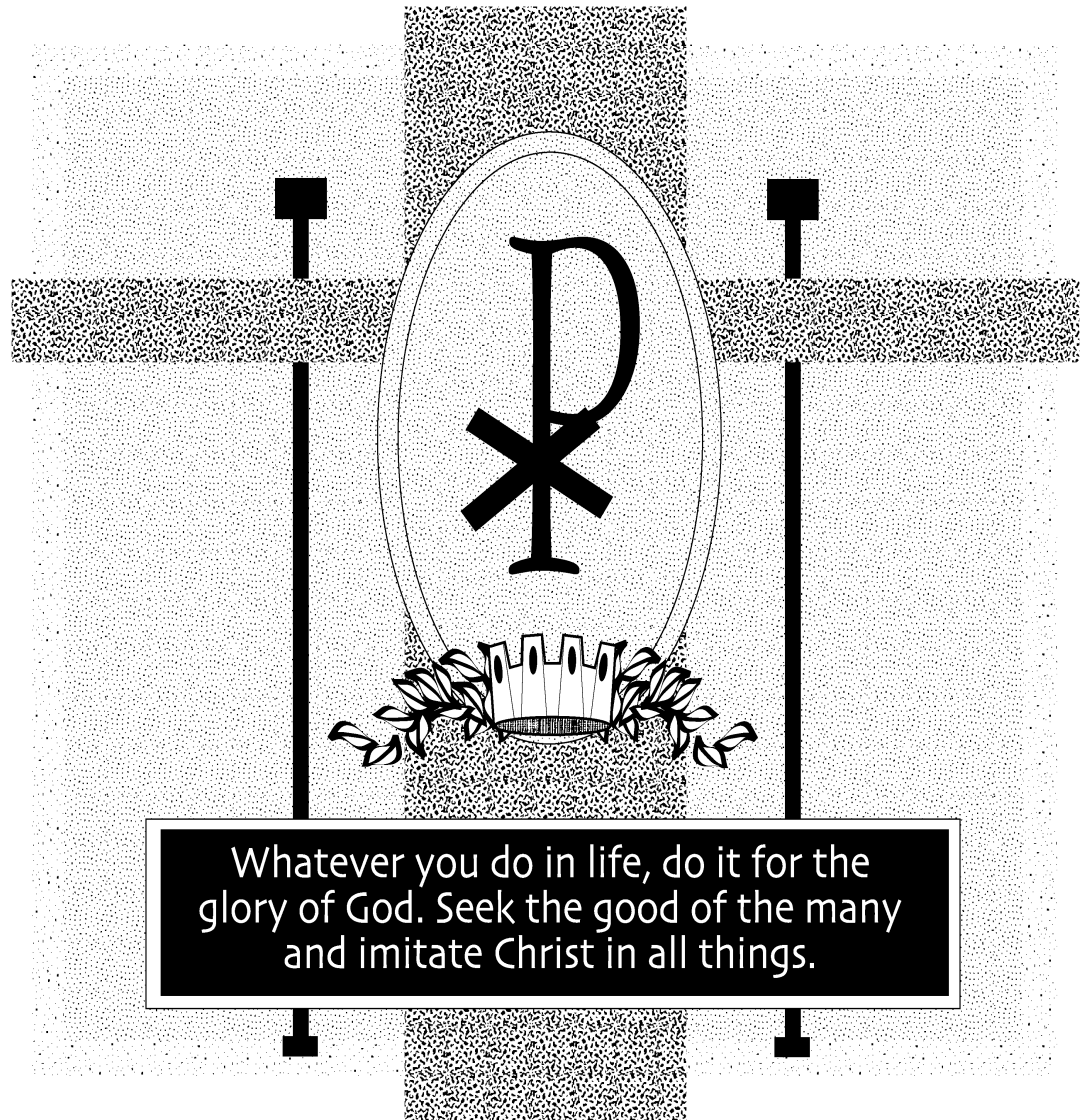
Sixth Sunday of Ordinary Time February 12, 2012

Respect Life – The National Vietnam Memorial in Washington DC is a shiny black wall that stretches 492 feet and lists the names of the 58,022 known Americans killed in that war. **If such a wall listed the names of the children killed by abortion since 1973, the wall would be about 60 miles long! The casualties of our wars put together are fewer than the casualties from abortion in a single year.**

From Your Priest...

I am so grateful to the Catholic Daughters of the Americas for implementing the Spiritual Adoption program in our parishes. Our Lady of Good Counsel CDA members began their first phase of the program last weekend and St. Adrian begins this weekend. You may adopt a child from any or all of the parishes if you wish. Faith formation students in grades 5-11 received their Spiritual Adoption prayer cards this week. St. Anthony CDA members will begin their first phase of this program in a couple months. This will give us plenty of opportunities to pray specifically for a child who is in danger of abortion.

The process is easy. You pick up a prayer card at the Spiritual Adoption Center in the back of the church. There is a prayer on the card which you must pray every day for a baby who is in danger of abortion. You name the baby and record its birth (conception) date (the day you picked up the card). Then you follow the development of your baby's growth process in the womb as each month a new phase of development is posted on the displays at Our Lady of Good Counsel and St. Adrian. At the end of nine months we will hold a birthday party for all of the babies we saved through this program.

We must all continue to grow in respect and love of human life. Each day we can do simple things to help us grow deeper in our understanding of the gift and mystery of our lives. Here is a quote from the Catechism of the Catholic Church on life. It has scriptural references to it. I hope it encourages you to grow ever fonder of your life and that of others: “Human life must be respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception. From the first moment of his existence, a human being must be recognized as having the rights of a person -- among which is the inviolable right of every innocent being to life. “Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you” (Jer 1:5; cf Job 10:8-12; Ps 22:10-11). “My frame was not hidden from you, when I was being made in secret, intricately wrought in the depths of the earth” (Ps. 139:15). Since the first century the Church has affirmed the moral evil of every procured abortion. This teaching has not changed and remains unchangeable.” -- Catechism of the Catholic Church, n. 2270-2271
