We had so many donations this year that we had to add Thursday afternoon to the sale hours! Even with Covid restrictions we had many people attend all three days. We only had two people not want to abide with wearing masks, and they did not enter. All our customers were very cooperative with the covid steps that we tried to enforce: everyone wore masks, people were recorded for contact tracing, sanitizer at the door, temperatures taken, numbers limited as needed,.

The Thrivent card of \$250 was used for the 2 pizzas and all the rest of the baking expenses, and publicity. 59 pies were made and they sold out in record time this year!

Thank you for all the months of sorting and labeling that were done before we even had the 25 days of the actual setup. We had people help that were not members of Concordia also. Thank you for everyone that helped during the setup, the baking, the three days of the sale, and the cleanup.

## **Community Hygiene Bank News**

### "Praise God from whom all Blessings flow"...

What a time of blessings for the Community Hygiene Bank! At our last distribution in September, we had 102 families come through for this curbside event. Though these numbers are the highest we've had, we were able to offer hygiene and food to everyone who came through. We had a number of new volunteers that day and thankfully our "regulars" and our student interns.

We just received a \$250 grant from Thrivent to help with the additional families we anticipate for our November 14 distribution. Brenda Carlson, from Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints is purchasing all the cleaning supplies for this distribution from their ministry budget. Tina Hundt purchased enough vegetables to make sure everyone gets two cans of corn. We are so grateful for all of these special gifts! We are planning for 120 families on November 14 150 families moving into the New Year. This is because many people have simply run out of any additional resources (personal and food items and cash reserves, etc) they may have had since COVID began in March. We have seen our numbers of families steadily increase since the Spring.

Besides the blessings of families, volunteers and Thrivent, we just received word from United Way that we will be receiving a \$9000 community crisis grant to help us meet the needs of these increased numbers of families over the next few months.

Because of this grant, we will also be able to hold an extra distribution for the public on Saturday, December 12, to help provide both needed items and a bit of holiday cheer for our neighbors in need,

Our sincere thanks to all of you who continue to support the work of the Hygiene Bank ministry through your hours of service, donation of cash and needed items or by keeping this work in prayer.

Our next distributions will be inside following COVID regulations. Everyone must wear a mask and be COVID screened.
