

How to adjust your text size on your web browser

Follow this procedure if you are using **Internet Explorer** on your PC to view your web page.

Step 1.

- Click once on your "View" button, which is located on the upper left corner of your screen menu.
- On the drop down menu list, which appears under the "View" button, go to "Text Size".
- On the pop out menu on the right, choose the "Largest" font size, or whichever size suits you best.

Step 2.

- Now your text size should be larger than before.
- Notice the text on the pictures (graphics) will remain the same.
- This setting will overwrite the default text setting on your browser, so you don't have to do this every time when you open a new browser window.
