Food - A Groceries-On-Wheels program will begin Thursday September 26th. Grocery orders can be placed by phone on Monday's and Thursday's from (9 am – noon) and will be delivered to

your home on Tuesday's and Friday's (noon -1pm). We will be shopping at Zup's in Ely. Zup's has agreed to open accounts for all participants. This service is available to the Babbitt area. Coffee, Tea And – Are served starting at 7am at the Senior Center located in the Babbitt Municipal Building. Everyone welcome! For regular patrons a dollar donation per week is suggested. The Senior Center will

also be hosting a senior flu shot clinic October 10th, please call or stop by for more details on this and other services offered at the Babbitt Senior Center 827-3770.



Laundry – The owner of the Babbitt Laundry, "The Lost Sock" reports they hope to reopen very soon. They did not suffer major damage and look forward to continuing to offer services in Babbitt.

We are awaiting more information from the store owner as to an estimated reopen date. Also a "Temporary" Pick-Up & Drop Off Service may start soon. The company, A Laundry Room, from Ely will be picking up bagged and labeled laundry at a designated site in Babbitt (up to) three times a week & returning your clean bagged and labeled laundry the same day to the site. The service usually charges \$1.25 per pound of laundry but will give our residents a rate of 80 cents per pound. They also do not usually pick up or deliver but will be doing this at no additional charge. The average weight of a hamper is 11-15 lbs. All participants will be billed by mail and will need to fill out a new customer form to begin. (Start Date & Babbitt Location Coming Soon)



Transportation - Several possibilities are being pursued. Currently a Ride-Share Board is up at the Babbitt City Hall. The board will be separated into two categories; (Need A Ride) and (Give A Ride). If you

'Need A Ride' for shopping, errands, etc. fill out the slip provided and post it on the board. If you can 'Give A Ride' fill out the slip provided and post it on that side of the board. All arrangements are up to the individuals receiving and giving rides. Call Ami with questions.
