MEET INFORMATION

In order to run a track meet that is sharp, it must move along on a definite time schedule. The following items should be read over to your team so we can have complete cooperation among everyone and the meet can be run as smoothly as possible.

1. Entries for 2012 should be emailed to dave@jtrackcc.com by listing those entries in regular email format or attaching a Word or Excel document of entries. You will receive a reply email confirming your entries within 24 hrs. Be sure to print a copy. The deadline for entries is Thursday, April 5, 2012, at 10 p.m.
2. All team members and coaches should enter through the main gate and be sure to get hands stamped.
3. Upon arrival, coaches should report to the Press Box and pick up relay cards. Your first runner of each relay team must present the proper card, filled out with the names of the runners on the team when reporting to the clerk for the first time in the event. **Also, make your scratches.**
4. Quincy Senior High will furnish all starting blocks. Each school will furnish its own towels, batons, shot puts and discs.
5. Coaches and contestants should station themselves in the bleachers and stay there! Do not stand at the Finish Line or along the track.
6. Each contestant entered in both a track/field event should notify the field official so that he/she will not be scratched from his/her event.
7. The shot and disc rings are concrete and flats must be worn.
8. The meet will be run on Chevron Fastrack 400. The long jump and pole vault runways are also all-weather. Contestants should wear flats or 1/4" spikes only. Flats only on the high jump pad.
9. No preliminaries--All races will be run as finals. Last fast heat--please be accurate with times.
10. Height of the bar in pole vault will start at 9'6". The high jump for boys will start at 5'2" and for girls will start at 4'6".
11. Lanes for the final: best times in lanes 3 and 4, next best times in lanes 2 and 5 and slower times in lanes 1 and 6.
12. FALSE START RULE WILL BE FOLLOWED.

13. First and second place trophies will be awarded to the top two teams. Medals will be awarded for the first, second and third places.
14. All events will be scored TBA.
15. Contestants shall not compete in more than four (4) events (track and field), in accordance with the Illinois High School Association.
16. Each school is allowed two (2) entries in individual events and one relay team in relay events.
17. No events will be held up if a contestant is not ready.
18. Coaches and contestants are not allowed around the Finish Line or on the Football field. You will be disqualified.
19. Results will be provided to all teams following the meet.
20. Admission prices will be \$3.00 for adults and \$2.00 for students.
21. A concession stand will be open.
22. Tennis ball halves will be provided for all relay markers. Please do not use chalk or tape for relay markers.
23. The meet management reserves the right to make any necessary changes to improve the administration of the meet.
