## VIATICUM

When a dying person receives Holy Communion, it is called Viaticum. The Church, in its Code of Canon Law, obliges all Catholics in danger of death, to receive Viaticum if they are able. It is the true, last Sacrament of the Christian life.

Even if they have received Communion in the same day, those who are in danger of death are strongly urged to receive again. Even baptized children who have not made their first Holy Communion, if they are able to distinguish the Holy Eucharist from ordinary food, may receive if they are in danger of death.

In ancient Rome, viaticum was the money or supplies provided a soldier going on a mission. For Catholics, Viaticum is food for the journey out of this world.
