MISSIONARY NEXT WEEKEND



- Fr. Jim Nero, OFM, a Franciscan priest, will be here next weekend to make an appeal on behalf of the Diocese of Mandeville, Jamaica, West Indies.
- This will be our annual participation in the Missionary Cooperative Plan of the United States. Under this plan, every Catholic parish in the country, on one weekend a year, hosts a missionary who makes an appeal on behalf of the mission he represents.
- This is the one time of year when an actual second collection is taken up, that is, the basket will be passed twice, the second time for the mission.
- Please be as generous as possible, because Jamaica is the second poorest country in the Western Hemisphere, after Haiti. In the Diocese of Mandeville there are about 600,000 people, 68% of whom have no running water. The people there need the basic necessities of life: food, clothing, shoes to wear, mattresses. There is an alarming number of destitute elderly and abandoned/neglected/abused children. People are dying every day from diseases which no longer exist in the United States. Some people are completely homeless, and many live in shacks of zinc with dirt floors.
- The Church is doing immense good there. The Bishop tries to build 20 houses a month for the poor. These houses are 12x20 feet, without electricity or running water, but each home is a castle to its inhabitants.
