PROPOSED DRESS CODE

for

MASS at ST. MALACHY'S

- The Mass is the Holy Sacrifice and Holy Supper of the Lord. At Mass, we are invited to the table of the King of Kings. Therefore, it is fitting to dress up a bit. At the very least, everyone should try to look neat and clean, in so far as possible.
- Women should not wear excessively low neck lines. Neither men nor women should have bare midsections.
- Women's hemlines should reach down at least to just above the knee.
- In very hot weather, if people wear shorts, they should reach down at least to just above the knee and should not be tight fitting.
- The practice of women covering their heads with a mantilla or scarf is excellent, but in no way required.
- This Dress Code is for those 10 years of age and up. Younger children will not be bound by it.
