I would like to alert you to the following building projects which have been recently completed or will be completed this summer:

- *The landing and stairs of the Church service entrance on the back side of the Church had rotted through and had to be rebuilt. This was done by Mikalunas Builder's, LLC.*
- *Parts of the stone, front steps of the Church are breaking apart and will be prepared or replaced.*
- *The front doors of the Church will be refinished and sealed.*
- *The parking lots and driveways of the Church will be resealed. This will be done by Bull Thistle Enterprises, Inc.*
- *A new roof will be put on the Church. This will be done by Ashcraft Builder.*
