

## MISSION APPEAL THIS WEEKEND

- ✦ Brother Kevin Piper, SC, a member of the American branch of the Brothers of the Sacred Heart (Sacre-Coeur), is with us this weekend to make an appeal on behalf of the African Missions of the Brothers of the Sacred Heart.
- ✦ This will be our annual participation in the Missionary Cooperative Plan of the United States. Under this plan, every Catholic parish in the country, on one weekend a year, hosts a missionary who makes an appeal on behalf of the mission he represents.
- ✦ This is the one time a year when an actual second collection is taken up, that is, the basket will be passed twice, the second time for the mission.
- ✦ The Brothers of the Sacred Heart were founded in 1821 in France "to rescue young people from ignorance, to prepare them for life, and to give them a knowledge and love of religion", as their rule states. The American brothers have missions in Kenya, Lesotho, Uganda, Zambia and Zimbabwe, where most of the brothers are now native Africans, which testifies to the vitality of the Church in Africa.
