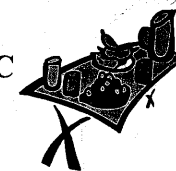
- Leaving Monday morning, June 29th, returning Tuesday evening, June 30th.

PLENARY INDULGENCE FOR THE YEAR OF SAINT PAUL

A Wonderful Opportunity – Next Friday, June 12th, members of the Catholic Church may gain a plenary indulgence (the remission of all temporal punishment due to sin) for themselves or for a deceased person by attending and receiving Holy Communion at 9:00 AM Mass at St. Paul's Church in Norwich, provided they fulfill the following conditions:
