PLENARY INDULGENCE FOR THE YEAR OF SAINT PAUL

A Wonderful Opportunity – On June 12th of this year, members of the Catholic Church may gain a plenary indulgence (the remission of all temporal punishment due to sin) for themselves or for a deceased person by attending and receiving Holy Communion at 9:00 AM Mass at St. Paul's Church in Norwich, provided they fulfill the following conditions:

- Celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Go to confession) within a time period stretching from two weeks before the Mass to two weeks after the Mass,
- Be free from all attachment to any sin, even venial sin,
- Be in a state of grace,
- Pray once the Lord's Prayer and the Hail Mary for the intentions of the Pope, and,
- Have the **intention** to gain the indulgence, either for themselves or for the deceased person.
