NOVENA TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

In preparation for the great feast of Pentecost, everyone is invited to make the beautiful Novena to the Holy Spirit, which is to begin this Friday, May 14th and end on Saturday, May 22nd, the day before Pentecost. The nine consecutive days of the Novena derive from the nine days the 120 disciples, including the Virgin Mother and the Apostles, waited for the coming of the Spirit between the Ascension of our Lord and the Feast of Pentecost. The Novena prayers are on the big table in the back of Church.

WEAR RED FOR PENTECOST – The Liturgical color for the great Feast of Pentecost is red (Holy Spirit, tongues of fire, love). Therefore, everyone is invited to wear as much red as possible to Mass that weekend, May 22nd & 23rd, if they have anything red they can wear.

THE BISHOP'S HOPE APPEAL – It is time



once again for us to support the work of our Church through the annual Bishop's Hope Appeal. This appeal is of vital importance to the mission of Christ through: our university and hospital chaplains, outreach to the rural and urban poor, parish religious education, Catholic schools, family life programs and many other good works.

Every Catholic family in the Diocese should have received a letter from the Bishop, along with a pledge form. Extra pledge forms are in the pews this weekend for those who need one. Please turn in your completed pledge form at Mass next weekend, May 15th-16th, or mail it to St. Malachy's. Do not mail it to the Diocese. It must go through the parish.

This year our parish assessment is the same as it was last year - \$10,336.00. We are asking every family to pledge \$120.00 (\$10.00/month), more if possible. Any checks written should be made out: Hope Appeal.

Please be as generous as possible. Only if some families pledge more than \$120.00 will we make our assessment. Should we go over our assessment, St. Malachy's will receive back 50% of the amount by which we surpass the assessment. For years now, many families of St. Malachy's have pledged more than the requested amount, causing this parish to stand out among all the parishes of the Diocese, and to receive a timely windfall back. But all we ask is that you do the best you can.
