ALL SOULS DAY – This Monday, Nov. 2nd, is All Souls Day.



Everyone is invited to come to a unique and special Mass at 7:00 PM in St. Malachy's Church that day. At that Mass, the names of all parishioners who will have died in the previous 12 months will be slowly read out. Then there will be a long moment of silence for people to whisper the names of their own who have died. The Mass will then be offered for all those whose names have been read out or whispered.

ALL SOULS DAY ENVELOPES may be put into the collection at any time between now and the end of November, the month dedicated to prayer for the souls in purgatory. Masses will be offered throughout the coming year collectively for all those whose names have been written on the All Souls envelopes.
