### MY DEAR PARISHIONERS,

*About six months ago, the Parish Council discussed the possibility of getting an automatic external defibrillator for the Church. An external defibrillator is a device which can often save the life of a person who has a heart attack. The minutes between a heart attack and the arrival of emergency medical help are crucial. In those minutes, an external defibrillator can mean the difference between life and death.*

*Before purchasing a defibrillator, however, we have to have enough people willing to be trained in how to use it, so that there will be a good chance that someone who knows how to use it will be there at Mass. It is also advantageous that such people know how to administer CPR.*

*Therefore, we would like to ask for volunteers for training in how to use an automatic external defibrillator and, possibly, training in CPR. If you would like to serve in this way, please sign up in the vestibule. If you already know CPR, please indicate that on the sign-up sheet too. Thank you.*
