Ogden Marriott Hotel Information

The Marriott is located on historic 24th Street in downtown Ogden. Many of you may remember the Ogden Depot; it was a regular stop for military personnel on their way to deployment. This area includes a large variety of wonderful restaurants, shops, a Remington Gun Museum, Rail Road Museum, the Solomon Center with indoor skydiving, surfing, bowling, Gold's gym, and much, much more within walking distance of the hotel. **Parking** is plentiful and free with easy access and lots of lighting.

ROOM RATES: All 388th BG Members will receive the preferred rate of \$65 maximum per night for single or double occupancy + applicable taxes of approx. 11.7%. Triple, quad, and Jr. King Suites are available at very reasonable rates. As has been in previous years, this rate is good from Aug. 31st through Sept. 9 if you would like to extend your stay. Reservations can be made on-line, www.marriott.com, through Marriott reservations at 888-236-2427, or directly with the Ogden Marriott by calling 801-627-1190. Use the rate code, "BOM Group" when making your reservation.

CUT-OFF DATE: Tuesday, August 25, 2008, is the cut-off-date for guaranteed reservations. After that date the Marriott will only be able to offer members reservations on a space – and – rate available basis. The folks at the Marriott have been wonderful to work with, so if you find yourself in the last minute mode, give them a call, you may be pleasantly surprised!

SALT LAKE CITY AIRPORT: Express Shuttle will provide transportation to the Ogden Marriott if you would like. The one-way rate is \$30 for the first person, then \$14 each for additional members of the same party. Find the "**EXPRESS SHUTTLE**" sign in baggage claim and their representative will check passengers in. Drivers can accept cash but no checks; *however*, reservations made 24 hours in advance, and credit card payments are preferred. Cancellation must be 24 hrs. in advance in order to avoid any penalty. **RESERVATION NO.: 800-397-0773**, identify yourself as a "**388th BG**" member. All major car rental companies are conveniently located at the airport and it is an easy 30 to 45 minute drive to the Marriott. Take I-80 East, to I-215 North, to I-15 North, Exit #342, turn right onto 24th Street. The hotel is 2.5 miles on the right.
