PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Children: They Are Precious to God, the Family and the Church

What a beautiful and sweet sight the children were on Sunday morning, De. 16th as they performed their wonderful Christmas program! I don't think any of us there that day could help but think how meaningful it was to see them after the heartwrenching tragedy in Connecticut. I'm sure people all over the world hugged their kids a little tighter even as they prayed for the families of Newtown. Jesus loves children and he certainly showed that when he was with his disciples. One of my favorite stories about him is when the kids wanted to be with him—they sensed something special about this man—and the disciples tried to shoo them away. Jesus was an important man after all and he was busy with all that healing and teaching. His time on earth as limited. But lesus would have none of that attitude— "Let the children be with me!" He said. What a lesson for the disciples and for us. So, how do we show them how




