HOLY WEEK

Palm/Passion Sunday

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

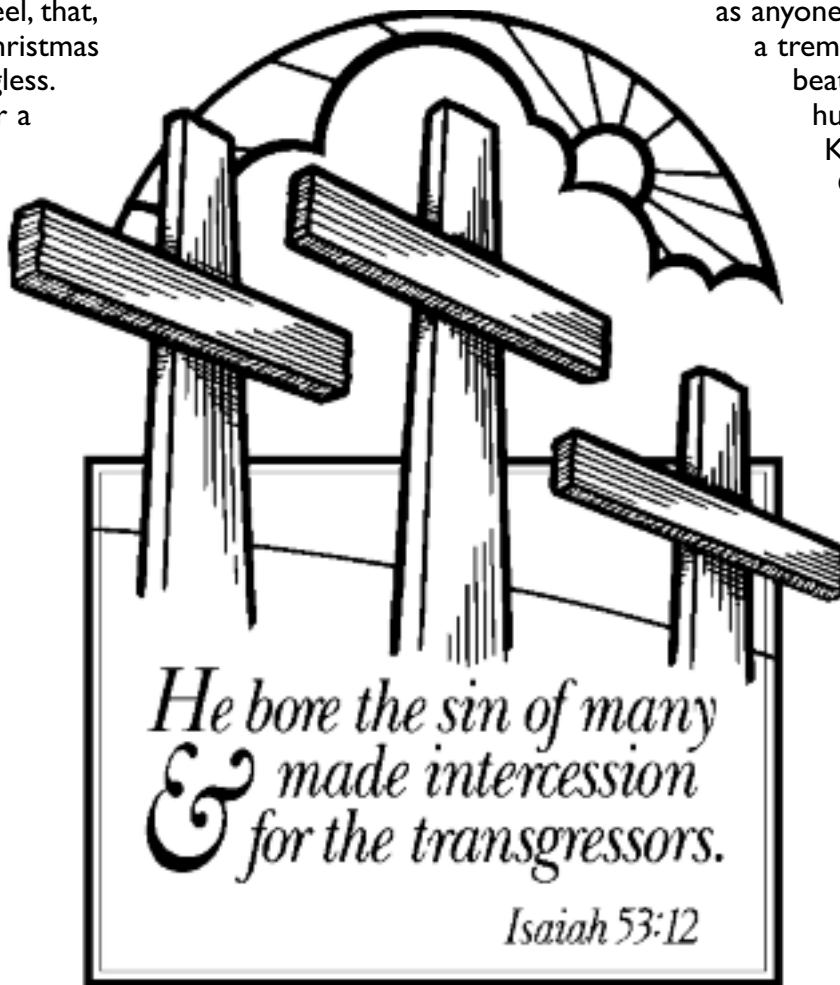
Easter:

The Best Time of the Year

Many people think that Christmas, with the birth of our Savior, is the best time of the year for Christians. But I feel, that, without Easter, Christmas would be meaningless.

Jesus was born for a purpose, but he still had to fulfill that purpose. Easter is the result of Jesus' great love for us. He stayed true to his mission despite the persecution and despite the humiliation. Do we really know how hard it was for him to remain on the cross and continue in the suffering? They mocked him, "You, who say you have the power, come down off that cross!" He could have ended his

suffering right then and there. He was fully human, he felt the extreme pain of the crucifixion as much as anyone would. Plus, he endured a tremendous whipping and beating. He endured the humiliation of it all. HE KNEW THAT HE COULD STOP IT. Just think of the willpower that took, and all for us.



It is so important during the Lenten Season that we walk with Jesus to the cross. It is important that we participate in that Last Supper with him, and that we stand at the foot of the cross on Good Friday. And then, that we celebrate the glory of the resurrection on Easter morning. Christ has risen! He has risen indeed! May God bless our Lenten and Easter journeys!

EASTER GARDEN FLOWERS

The annual Easter memorial flower sale will start March 3. Help celebrate the glory of Easter Sunday by adding a plant to our Easter Garden.

Order forms will be inserted into the bulletins March 3, 10, and 17 and will also be available in the church office. All orders are due to the church office BY SUNDAY, MARCH 17. There will again be a variety of plants available. In the past, we have had Easter Lilies, Mums, Cyclamen, and Calandiva. Final selection and pricing has not yet been confirmed, but will be listed on the order forms. Please note: we need 15 Easter Lilies to fill our cross and altar.

MARCH IS MN FOODSHARE MONTH

There will be a grocery cart in the Narthex during the month of March. Please consider donating non-perishable food items for our local food shelf. Cash donations are also welcome, and can be left in the church office. Food shelves can stretch cash donations further because of their access to discount products and programs. Cash also gives them more flexibility to acquire perishable items like fresh produce, meat and dairy products.

Each year, Minnesota FoodShare directs the March Campaign, the largest food drive in the state, and restocks 300 food shelves across Minnesota. Throughout the year, Minnesota FoodShare advocates on behalf of hungry Minnesota families with both state and federal lawmakers and educates the public about hunger in Minnesota.

Each Sunday in March, we are also asking our Sunday School students to bring in one (or more!) non-perishable food item in place of their regular Sunday School money offerings.

Family Projects: A fun idea for families to work on together is to gather items for a whole meal. For example, a box of spaghetti, a can of spaghetti sauce, a container of parmesan cheese, a can of vegetables, a can of fruit, and a box of brownie mix.

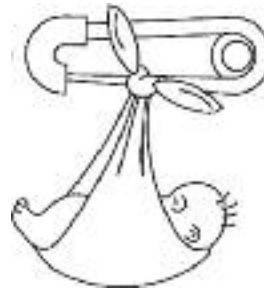
