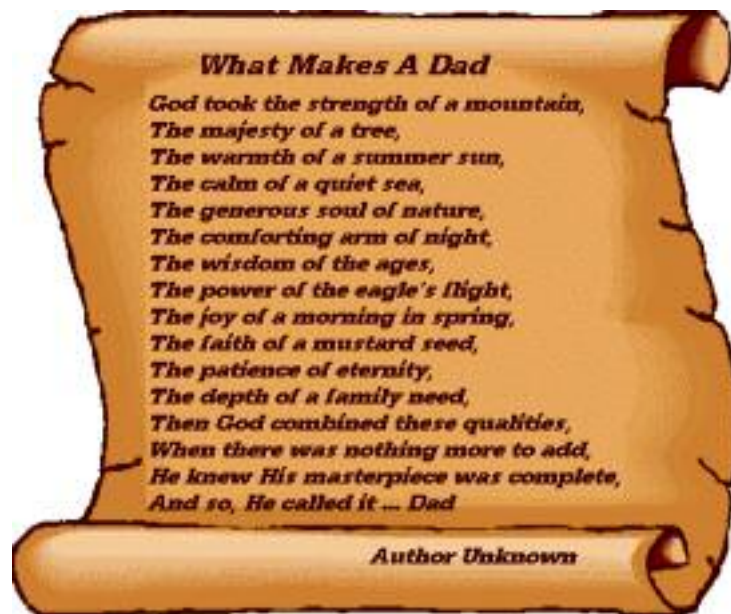

# PASTOR'S MESSAGE

## Agriculture Sunday - June 2nd

Stewardship of creation is an on-going ministry in the church. The creation that God declared "good" in Genesis is entrusted to the care of humankind.

Exercising that care is one dimension of daily

Christian discipleship. Having Agriculture Sunday (called Rogation Sunday in the ancient church) is one way for the church to honor God for the gift of creation and to pray for the land, the gift of labor, and the needs of all people.

One thing I have enjoyed in my commutes to Immanuel is watching how the fields change throughout the seasons. I

always take the back roads to and from Spicer and I have been watching the process of spring planting. How different it is now than when my father planted with a six hole planter! It is amazing how the yield per acre has increased and how many people the typical American farmer feeds now days. I am grateful to the farmers for the work that they do—especially for the local farmers.

On June 2nd we will pray for a blessing for the soil, seeds, water and equipment. We will pray for safety, favorable weather, and a bountiful harvest to come. Jesus often used parables that had to do with the land and its care. In Biblical days everyone understood that tie to the land. We are fortunate,

in our area, to feel that same tie, even though it is lessening throughout the United States as the country becomes more urbanized.



I was interested to hear the story of Immanuel's God's Acre Project. In the early spring of 1959 the church members were surprised to see a small gold container on the altar. It contained 90 soybeans and it was the beginning of a tithing project. The beans were planted on church property and increased 10-fold that first year. By the fifth year, it took 11 members of Immanuel to plant and harvest

the crop. Since then.....

That is an amazing story!

As part of Agriculture Sunday we will pray this prayer:

*God, our Creator, you have ordered seedtime, sunshine, rain, and harvest. You have created the seed, soil, and water so there may be food for all your people. May we honor and care for these elements that sustain our earthly life. As the food nourishes our bodies may we be filled with praise and thanksgiving for our Creator. Amen.*

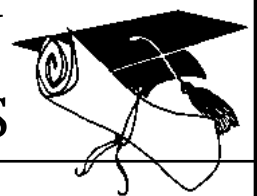
# BLOCK NURSE PROGRAM ACTIVITIES

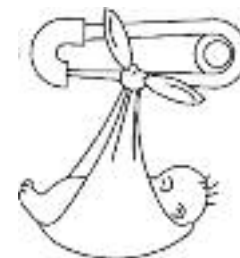
