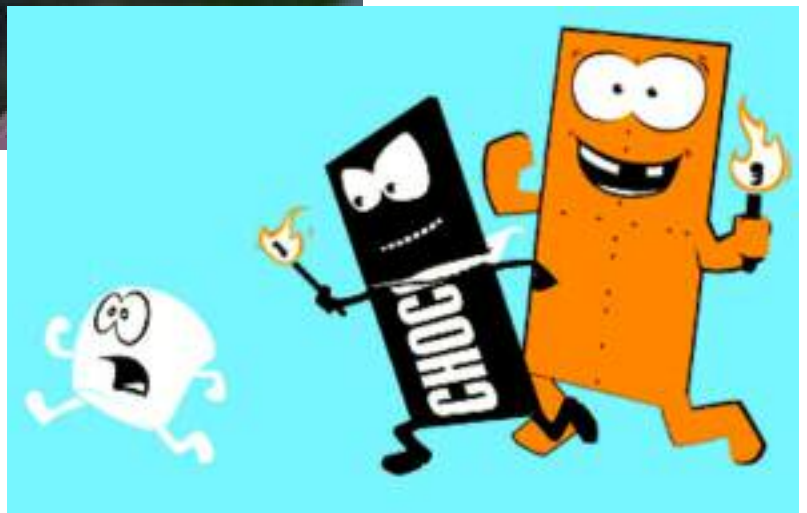

Pastor's Message - From Page 3

If it's felt like a long wait getting to August 4th for you, we have felt similarly. This summer has been a bit of a whirlwind, but a whirlwind filled with God's Spirit.

A passage in Scripture that has helped me immensely both in letting go of my previous home and call and in longing to be with all of you is Matthew 7. It is Jesus' parable about the wise and foolish builders

²⁴ "Jesus said, 'Everyone then who hears these words of mine and acts on them will be like a wise man who built his house on rock. ²⁵ The rain fell, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house, but it did not fall, because it had been founded on rock. ²⁶ And everyone who hears these words of mine and does not act on them will be like a foolish man who built his house on sand. ²⁷ The rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell—and great was its fall!"

If you've basked in the heat and joys of summer or are caught in your own turbulent circumstances of life --- this passage is clear. Jesus' words and who Jesus is really matters to our day to day life. In Christ, we find our foundation --- a foundation, hope, and life that can withstand the highest of heights and the depths of challenge. With Christ as our foundation, we can build anything!

Often times in congregations and churches, we are tempted to be like the foolish builder... looking to a pastor or certain congregation leaders to lead us or guide us. When in reality --- it is not one per-

son, pastor or parishioner, council chair person or staff member, who makes or breaks a church. It is not the pastor, staff, council, or lay leaders who lead and guide a church. It is God in Christ Jesus.

One of the first questions the call committee asked me was, "How would you grow Immanuel Lutheran and reach out to young adults and families?" I heard what is asked everywhere, "Pastor, how will you get young people and young families in our doors?" I answered with the only thing I could. I said that was not my goal for Immanuel. Now sure, do I want young adults, young families, and people of all ages to come through our doors and feel the love and warmth of the body of Christ and long to stay? --- Absolutely! But, it is not my goal to use a certain gimmick or program. Instead, I said, "My hope and prayer is to lead and guide at Immanuel so that I am continually pointing us to God in Christ Jesus, our hope, our meaning, our purpose. I believe that if we focus on becoming the family of God that Christ is calling us to be, then Immanuel Lutheran will be a place where people want to invite friends of all ages and it will be a place where people come, feel welcome, and long to stay and grow in faith together." That is still my answer and vision for Immanuel. I am overjoyed that August is here, and God is finally joining our forces together.

Let's build together --- with our eyes, minds, and hearts fixed on God in Christ Jesus. The one who loves you with a love that will never let you go! That's good news worth building on & sharing!
