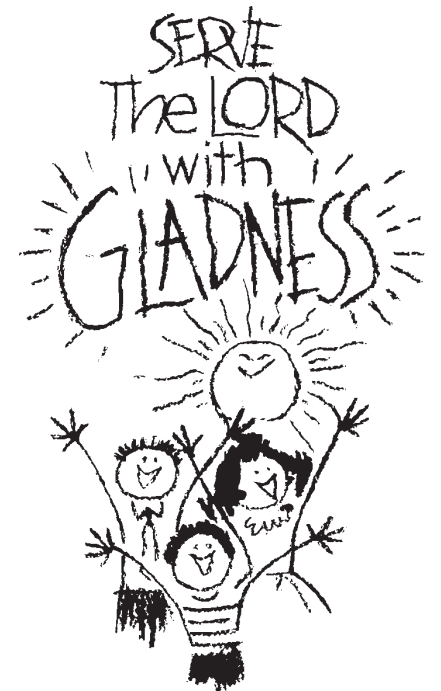

First Lesson **Numbers 11:24-30**

^{11:24} So Moses went out and told the people the words of the LORD; and he gathered seventy elders of the people, and placed them all around the tent. ^{11:25} Then the LORD came down in the cloud and spoke to him, and took some of the spirit that was on him and put it on the seventy elders; and when the spirit rested upon them, they prophesied. But they did not do so again. ^{11:26} Two men remained in the camp, one named Eldad, and the other named Medad, and the spirit rested on them; they were among those registered, but they had not gone out to the tent, and so they prophesied in the camp. ^{11:27} And a young man ran and told Moses, "Eldad and Medad are prophesying in the camp." ^{11:28} And Joshua son of Nun, the assistant of Moses, one of his chosen men, said, "My lord Moses, stop them!" ^{11:29} But Moses said to him, "Are you jealous for my sake? ^{12:3b} No one can say "Jesus is Lord" except by the Holy Spirit. ^{12:4} Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; ^{12:5} and there are varieties of services, but the same Lord; ^{12:6} and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone. ^{12:7} To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. ^{12:8} To one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit, ^{12:9} to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit, ^{12:10} to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the discernment of spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. ^{12:11} All these are activated by one and the same Spirit, who allots to each one individually just as the Spirit chooses. ^{12:12} For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. ^{12:13} For in the one Spirit we were all baptized into one body--Jews or Greeks, slaves or free--and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.
