

In Christ All Are Made Alive

"For since through a man (Adam) came death, through **a Man (Jesus)** came also the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, even so **in Christ All shall be Made Alive**. But each man in his own order: Christ the first-fruits; afterward those who are Christ's at His coming. Then comes the end: when **He (Jesus)** shall have delivered up the Kingdom to God, even the Father; when **He** shall have put down all rule and all authority and power. For **He must reign**, until He has put all enemies under His feet. The last enemy that shall be destroyed **is death**." (1 Corinthians 15:21-25)

"For **the law of the Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus** has set me (or you) free from the law of **sin and death**." (Romans 8:2)

In Christ: from the greek words ***en Christo*** which mean: in Christ! In context: in Christ Jesus all who are spiritually born-again, and dwelling in the Spirit of God, are now made alive in Christ Jesus through His Spirit: from spiritual-death to Life in Christ Jesus!

All: from the greek word ***pantes*** which means: all, everyone, everything, all things, the whole; In context: all believers who are 'in Christ Jesus' and He in them.

Shall Be Made Alive: from the greek word ***zoopoiethesontai*** which means: shall-be-made-alive; from ***zoopoieo***: to make alive, to give life. In context: to cause someone who is dead (spiritually) to have life; and to be empowered with divine spiritual life.

Spirit of Life: from the greek words ***Pneumatos tes zoes*** which mean: Spirit of Life; refers to the Holy Spirit: the Spirit of God the Father and His Son Jesus the Christ-Messiah; as Jesus Himself promised:

"If you love Me, keep My commandments. And I will ask the Father, and He shall give you another **Comforter**, so that He may **abide (live)** with you forever; even **the Spirit of Truth**; whom the world cannot receive, because it sees Him not, nor knows Him; but you know Him; for **He dwells (lives) with you, and shall be in you**." (John 14:15-17)

Paul, the apostle of Christ Jesus also spoke of the Holy Spirit of Life in us as follows:

"Those who are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but those who are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit. For to be carnally minded is death; but **to be spiritually minded is Life and Peace**. Because the carnal mind is at enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, indeed, nor can be. So then those who are in the flesh cannot please God. But you are not in the flesh, **but in the Spirit**, if so be that the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if any man does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is none of His. But if Christ is in you, the body is dead because of sin; but **the Spirit is life** because of righteousness. But if the Spirit of Him (the Father) who raised up Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He (the Father) who raised up Christ from the dead shall also Make-alive your mortal bodies **through His Spirit who dwells (lives) in you**." (Romans 8:5-11)

We are made alive In Christ because Jesus is Life! Please consider the following:

"**In the beginning was the Word** (speaking of Jesus), and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. **The Same** was in the beginning with God. All things were made **through Him**; and without Him was not any thing made that was made. **In Him was Life**; and **the Life was the Light of men**." (John 1:1-4)

And again:

"Then Jesus spoke again unto them, saying, 'I am the Light of the world; he who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.' " ([John 8:12](#))

Jesus saith unto him, I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life: no man comes unto the Father, except through Me." ([John 14:6](#))

Fundamental of Christ Jesus Coming: was to provide for us everlasting abundant Life in and through Him:

"**Truly, truly**, I say unto you, 'He who hears My word, and believes on Him (the Father) who sent Me, has Everlasting Life, and shall not come into condemnation; **but has passed from death unto Life**. Truly, truly, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and those who hear shall live. For as the Father has Life in Himself; so He has given to the Son to have Life in Himself; and has given Him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of Man. Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in which all who are in the graves shall hear His voice, and shall come forth; those who have done good, unto the Resurrection of Life; and those who have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.' " ([John 5:24-29](#))

Jesus said, "For the **Bread of God** is He who comes down from heaven, and gives Life unto the world. Then said they unto Him, 'Lord, forevermore give us this bread.' And Jesus said unto them, 'I am the Bread of Life: he who comes to Me shall never hunger; and he who believes on Me shall never thirst. But I said unto you, that you also have seen Me, and do not believe. All who the Father gives Me shall come to Me; and he who comes to Me I will in no wise cast out. For I came down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him (the Father) who sent Me. And this is the Father's will who has sent Me: that of all whom He has given to Me I should lose none, but should raise them up again at the last day. And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that **everyone who sees the Son, and believes on Him, may have Everlasting Life**: and I will raise him up at the last day.' " ([John 6:33-40](#))

"Then said Jesus unto them again, '**Truly, truly**, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep. All who ever came before Me are thieves and robbers; but the sheep did not hear them. I am the door; through Me if any man enters in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture. The thief comes not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I have come that they might have Life, and that they might have it more abundantly. I am the Good Shepherd. The Good Shepherd gives His life for the sheep.' " ([John 10:7-11](#))

"Then Martha, as soon as she heard that Jesus was coming, went and met Him; but Mary sat still in the house. Then said Martha unto Jesus, 'Lord, if You had been here, my brother (Lazarus) would not have died. But I know, that even now, whatever You will ask of God, God will give it to You.' Jesus said unto her, 'Your brother shall rise again.' Martha said unto Him, 'I know that he shall rise again in the Resurrection at the Last Day.' Jesus said unto her, 'I am the Resurrection, and the Life: he who believes in Me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: And whosoever lives and believes in me shall never die. Do you believe this?' She said unto Him, 'Yes, Lord: I believe that You are the Christ, the Son of God, who should come into the world.' " ([John 11:20-27](#))

Speaking to His Father Jesus said, "And this is Life Eternal, that they (believers) might know You the only True God, and Jesus Christ, whom You have sent." ([John 17:3](#))

The apostles of Jesus clearly wrote of believers as being made-alive in Christ Jesus. Truly Christ Jesus is our Life – even eternally! Please consider the following:

"For I through the law am dead to the law, so that **I might live** unto God. I am crucified (putting to death the old man) with Christ; nevertheless **I live**; yet not I, **but Christ lives in me**: and the **Life** which I now live in the flesh **I live** by the faith **of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave Himself for me.**" ([Galatians 2:19-20](#))

"If you then are risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sits on the **Right Hand of God**. Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. For you are dead, and **your life is hid with Christ in God. When Christ, Who is our life,** shall appear, then you shall also appear **with Him in glory.**" ([Colossians 3:1-4](#))

"For God, who commanded the Light to shine **out of darkness**, has shined in our hearts, to give the Light of the knowledge of the Glory of God **in the face of Jesus Christ**. But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us. *We are* troubled on every side, yet not distressed; perplexed, but not in despair; Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed; always bearing about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, so that **the Life also of Jesus** might be made manifest in our body. For we **who live** are always delivered unto death for Jesus' sake, so that **the Life also of Jesus** might be made manifest in our mortal flesh." ([2 Corinthians 4:6-11](#))

"And this is the record, that God has given to us Eternal Life, and **this Life is in His Son. He who has the Son has Life**; and he who does not have the Son of God does not have not Life. These things have I written unto **you who believe** on the **Name of the Son of God**; so that you **may know** that you **have Eternal Life**, and that you may believe on the Name of the Son of God." ([1 John 5:11-13](#))

"These are written, so that you **might believe** that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that **believing** you might **have Life through His Name.**" (John 20:31)
