Jesus said, "But **the Comforter**, who is **the Holy Spirit**, whom the Father will send in My Name, **He** shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you. **Peace I leave with you, My Peace I give unto you**; not as the world gives, give I unto you. **Let not your heart be troubled, nor let it be afraid.**" ([John 14:26-27](#))

"For the **fruit of the Spirit** is love, joy, **Peace**, long-suffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance; against these there is no law. And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts. If **we live in the Spirit**, let us also **walk in the Spirit.**" ([Galatians 5:22-25](#))

**Peace:** From the Greek word ***eirenen* (*eirene*)** which means: peace; mental calmness and quietness, serenity, peace of mind, well being, tranquility within one's soul; whether free from, or in the midst of: stress, enmity, hostility, conflict, fear, trouble, disputes, dissension, etc. Our Peace in Christ Jesus, the Peace of God, encompasses the blessed assurance of our salvation in and through Christ Jesus, and so we do not fear condemnation from God; and are content with our earthly lot, whatever that situation may be. Please consider the following:

Jesus said, "These things I have spoken unto you, **that in Me (in Jesus!) you might have Peace**. In the world you **will have tribulation**; but be gladly-courageous; I have overcome the world." ([John 16:33](#)) - see chapter 16 in context)

Jesus is indeed prophetically, the Prince of our Peace as spoken by prophets. Please consider the following:

"For unto us **a Child** is born (speaking of Jesus's first coming), unto us **a Son** is given; and **the government shall be upon His shoulder**: and **His** name shall be called Wonderful Counsellor, The **Mighty God**, The **Everlasting Father**, The **Prince of Peace**. Of the increase of **His government and Peace** there shall be **no end**, upon the throne of David, **and upon His Kingdom**, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth **even forever**. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this." ([Isaiah 9:6-7](#))

"Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, **your King (Jesus) comes unto you; He is Just**, and **having Salvation**; lowly, and riding upon a donkey, and upon a colt the foal of a donkey. ... and He shall speak Peace unto the nations; and **His dominion** shall be from sea even to sea, and from the river even to the ends of the earth." ([Zechariah 9:9-10](#)) (see its fulfillment in: [John 12:12-15](#))

"Thus speaks the LORD of hosts, saying, Behold **the Man (Jesus)** whose name is **The Branch**; and **He** shall grow up out of His place, and **He** shall build the Temple of the LORD. Even He shall build the Temple of the LORD; and **He** shall bear the glory, and shall sit and rule upon **His Throne**; and **He** shall be a priest upon **His Throne**; and **the Counsel of Peace** shall be between them both." ([Zechariah 6:12-13](#))

**Peace:** From the Hebrew word ***shalom*** which means: peace; similar in meaning as the greek definition above, but with additional attributes: completeness, soundness, welfare, etc.

The New Testament begins with prophetic announcements of our peace with God being realized in the first coming of Jesus to Earth as our Savior:

"And you, child (John the Baptist), shall be called the prophet of **the Highest** (of God the Father); for you shall go before the face of **the Lord (Jesus) to prepare His ways**; to give **knowledge of Salvation** unto His people in the remission of their sins, through the **tender mercy of our God**; whereby the Dayspring from on High (Jesus) has visited us, to give light to those who sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, **to guide our feet into the Way of Peace.**" ([Luke 1:76-](#)

"And the angel said unto them (the shepherds), 'Fear not: for, behold, I bring you Good-news of great joy, which shall be to **all people**. For unto you is born this day in the city of David **a Savior, who is Christ the Lord**. And this shall be a sign unto you: you shall find the baby wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger.' And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, "Glory to God in the Highest, and on Earth: Peace, good will toward men.' And it came to pass, after the angels were gone away from them into heaven, the shepherds said one to another, 'Let us now go even unto Bethlehem, and see this thing which is come to pass, which the Lord has made known unto us.' " ([Luke 2:10-15](#))

**This Peace and Good Will is for all people including both Jews and Gentiles! Please consider the following:**

"But now in Christ Jesus you (Gentiles) who formerly were far off are made near in the blood of Christ. For **He is our Peace**, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of partition; having abolished in His flesh the enmity, even the Law of commandments in ordinances; so that (with) the two (Jew and Gentile) He might create in Himself into one new man, so making Peace; and that He might reconcile **both** unto God in one body through the cross, having slain the enmity in it; and having-come **preached the Good-news: Peace to you** (Gentiles) who were afar off, and **Peace** to those (Jews) near. For **through Him we both** have access in one Spirit unto the Father." ([Ephesians 2:13-18](#))

"For the scripture says, '*Whoever believes on Him (Jesus) shall not be ashamed*' ([Isaiah 28:16](#)). For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek; for the same Lord (Jesus) over all is rich unto all who call upon Him. '*For whoever shall call upon the Name of the Lord shall be saved*' ([Joel 2:32](#)). How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe **in Him** (in Jesus) of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach, except they are sent? As it is written, '*How beautiful are the feet of those preaching Good-news of Peace; of those preaching Good-news of good-things*' ([Isaiah 52:7](#)). " ([Romans 10:11-15](#))

**Examples, and exhortations encouraging abiding in our peace from God:**

"And being fully persuaded that, what **He (God)** had promised, He was also able to perform. Therefore, it was imputed to him (Abraham) for righteousness. Now it was not written for his sake alone, that it was imputed to him; But **for us also**, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on Him (God) who raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead; who was delivered for our offenses, and was raised again for our justification. Therefore being Justified by faith, we have Peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ; through whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in Hope of the glory of God." ([Romans 4:21-25, 5:1-2](#))

"Now may the God of hope fill you **with all Joy and Peace** in believing, that you may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Spirit." ([Romans 15:13](#))

"Therefore, there is now no condemnation **to those who are in Christ Jesus**, who do not walk after the flesh, **but after the Spirit**. For the Law of the **Spirit of life in Christ Jesus** has made me free from the law of sin and death. For what the Law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending **His own Son (Jesus)** in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin: condemned sin in the flesh; so that the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, **but after the Spirit**. For those who are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but those who are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit. For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is Life and Peace." ([Romans 8:1-6](#))

"For the Kingdom of God is not food and drink: but Righteousness, and Peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit. For he who in these things serves Christ is acceptable to God, and approved of men. Let us therefore follow after the things **which make for Peace**, and things by which someone may edify (build-up) another." (Romans 14:17-19)

### Peace Promises from God's Word:

"You will keep him **in perfect Peace**, whose mind leans on You: because he trusts in You. Trust you in the LORD forever; for in the LORD YAHWEH is everlasting strength." (Isaiah 26:3)

"The work of righteousness shall be Peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance forever. And My people shall dwell in **a peaceable habitation**, and in sure dwellings, and in **quiet** resting places." (Isaiah 32:17-18)

"And the **gentle shall inherit the earth**; and shall delight themselves **in the abundance of Peace**." (Psalms 37:11)

"**Great Peace have those who love Your Law**; nothing shall offend them." (Psalms 119:165)

"And the fruit of Righteousness is sown in Peace of those who make Peace." (James 3:18)

"Now the **Lord of Peace Himself (Jesus)** give **you peace** always by all means. The Lord be with you all." (2 Thessalonians 3:16)

"Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the **Peace of God**, which surpasses all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. **Finally**, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are honest, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, **think (meditate) on these things**. Those things, which you have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, **do (them)**; and **the God of Peace shall be with you**." (Philippians 4:4-9)

"Finally brethren, farewell. Be perfect, be of good comfort, be of one mind, Live in Peace; and **the God of Love and Peace shall be with you**." (2 Corinthians 13:11)
