the FIRST AND THE LAST

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"And when I saw Him, I fell at His feet as dead. And He laid His right hand upon me, saying unto me, "Fear not; <u>I am the First and the Last</u>. I am <u>He who lives, and was dead;</u> and, behold, I am alive for evermore. Amen! And I have the keys of Hades and of death." (READ Rev 1:9-18)

"And unto the angel of the church in Smyrna write; "These things says the First and The Last, who was dead, and is alive;..." (Revelation 2:8)

"And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with Me, to give to every man according as his work has been. I am the Alpha and Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last. Blessed are they that do His commandments, that they may have right to the Tree of Life, and may enter in through the gates into the City." (Revelation 22:12-14)

First: from the Greek word *protos* which means: 'first, before, principal, most important, chief."

Last: from the Greek word *eschatos* which means: "last, at the last, final, finally, till the end."

When used together the title the First and the Last speaks of positional singularity or oneness.

Consider this same title as used by God the Father, for Himself, in the Old Testament:

"Thus says the LORD the King of Israel, and his Redeemer, the LORD of Hosts, "**Lam** the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no God. And who can proclaim as I do (I.e, who else can predict the future)? Let him declare it, and set it in order for Me, since I appointed the ancient people. And the things that are coming, and shall come, let them show unto them. Fear you not, neither be afraid; have not I told you from that time, and have declared it? You are even my witnesses. Is there a god beside Me? Indeed, there is no other Rock; **I know not any**." (Isaiah 44:6-8)

"Hearken unto Me, O Jacob and Israel, My called one; <u>I am He</u>; <u>I am the first, I also am</u> <u>the last.</u> <u>My hand also has laid the foundation of the earth</u>, and <u>My right hand</u> has spanned the heavens, when I call unto them, they stand up together." (Isaiah 48:12-13)

"You are My witnesses, says the LORD, and My servant whom I have chosen; that you may know and believe Me, and understand that <u>I Am He</u>; before <u>Me there was no god</u> <u>formed, neither shall there be after Me</u>. I, even I, <u>am the LORD</u>; and <u>beside Me there is</u> <u>no Savior</u>. I have declared, and have saved, and I have shown, when there was no strange god among you; therefore you are my witnesses, says the LORD, that <u>I Am God</u>. (Isaiah 43:10-12)

When God calls Himself **the First and the Last** in Isaiah 44:6-8 He is speaking, within the context of Himself being the one and only God in existence. He alone is the God of eternity past, and He alone knows eternity's future! He is the First God in line and the Last God in line; He is the only God in line; there are no other gods in between. There is only one God!

When God calls Himself **the First and the Last** in Isaiah <u>48:12-13</u> He is speaking, within the context of Himself being the one and only Creator in existence. He is the First in line and the Last in line; and there are no other creator-gods in between. There is only one Creator!

In <u>Isaiah 43:10-12</u> God is speaking of Himself as not only being the one and only God, <u>but also</u> the one and only Savior in existence. He is the First in line and the Last in line; and there are no other saviors in between. <u>There is only one Savior</u>!

When Jesus calls Himself the <u>the First and the Last</u> in the Rev. passages, He is quoting from the Isaiah verses in the same context as expressed by God in the Isaiah verses. He is our only God! He is our only Savior! Through Him all things were created! He and the Father are one!

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John, the apostle of Jesus, begins his Gospel declaring this essential truth concerning Jesus: "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. This One was in the beginning with God. <u>All things were made through Him; and without Him was not any thing made that was made.</u> In Him was Life; and the Life was the Light of men. And the Light shines in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not. ... <u>And the Word was made flesh (became human)</u>, and dwelt among us; and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth." (John 1:1-5. 14)

The apostle Paul also declares this essential truth concerning Jesus: "...giving thanks unto the Father, who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light; and who has delivered us from the power of darkness; and has translated us into the Kingdom of His dear Son; in whom we have redemption through His blood, even the forgiveness of sins. <u>He is the image of the invisible God</u>, the firstborn of every creature. For in Him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created through Him, and for Him. And He is before all things, and by Him all things consist." (Colossians 1:13-17)

Jesus applies additional context to the meaning of this title in regards to His human nature. He said, "I am the First and the Last" (speaking of His divinity). Then Jesus says, "I am He that lives, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore." (Revelation 1:17-18) Here, concerning His humanity, Jesus speaks of being alive; and then of His previous death on the cross for the forgiveness of our sins; and then of His resurrection from the dead back into life. Jesus is our Savior! He is the First Savior for sin in line, and the Last Savior for sin in line; and there are no other saviors in between. He is, in oneness with the Father, our one and only everlasting Savior!
