Names and Titles and Attributes of Jesus - For Kids

The Amen

List

Jesus said, "And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; 'These things says **the Amen**, the <u>Faithful and True Witness</u>, the Beginning of the Creation of God;' " (see Revelation 3: 14-22)

Amen: the root meanings are: **true**, **truth**, **faithful**, and **trustworthy**; sometimes translated **truly** or **verily** in the Bible when Jesus had something extra important to say to people. When used at the end of a prayer, or praise, Amen means "so let it be" as an expression of agreement, or desire, that the prayer would <u>be Faithful and True to the will of God</u>.

The Name 'Amen' of Jesus is reinforced with the very similar meaning Name: 'Faithful and True Witness.'

Faithful: loyal, constant, and steadfast; true to the original facts or message.

Trustworthy: able to be relied on as honest and truthful.

True: to be accurate and exact in accordance with fact and reality.

Truth: the quality or state of being true.

In Isaiah 65:16, the title of God the Father "the God of truth," is simply "the God of Amen", has similar meaning as the title 'Amen' that Jesus uses for Himself. Both the Father and Son Jesus are Truthful, Faithful, and Trustworthy!

"Therefore thus says the Lord Yahweh, "Behold, My servants shall eat, but you shall be hungry: behold, My servants shall drink, but you shall be thirsty: behold, My servants shall rejoice, but you shall be ashamed. Behold, My servants shall sing for joy of heart, but you shall cry for sorrow of heart, and shall howl for vexation of spirit. And you shall leave your name for a curse; that he who blesses himself in the earth shall bless himself in the God of Truth; and he who swears in the earth shall swear by the God of Truth; because the former troubles are forgotten, and because they are hid from My eyes. For, behold, I create new heavens and a new earth."" (see Isaiah 65:11-19)

Jesus, The Amen, and Faithful and True Witnesses says to lukewarm people:

"As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten. Be zealous therefore, and repent. Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hears my voice, and opens the door, I will come in to him, and will dine with him, and he with Me. To him who overcomes will I grant to sit with Me on My throne, even as I also overcame, and have sat down with My Father on His throne." (see Revelation 3: 14-22)

What the Father had to say to His people in <u>Isaiah chapter 65</u>, both to the unrighteous, and to His faithful servants will truly come to pass. What the Son Jesus had to say to the people in the Church of Laodicea will also trully come to pass.
