Names and Titles and Attributes of Jesus - For Kids

Associate

"Awake, O sword, <u>against My Shepherd</u>, and against **the Man who is <u>My Associate</u>** (My <u>Companion</u>), says the LORD of Hosts; <u>strike the Shepherd</u>, and the sheep shall be scattered..." (see Zechariah 13:7)

An Associate, is someone who is a close companion, a close friend, a close co-worker, a close partner – someone who closely participates in a mutually shared project, job, or goal, etc...

The supreme significance of this title of Jesus, '<u>My</u> Associate', is that it is <u>God the Father</u> Who is calling Jesus <u>His Associate</u>; and in context the Father is prophetically commanding the sentence of death towards **His beloved Associate** – Jesus the Son of God!. This is and always was <u>an eternal understanding</u> between the Father and His Son Jesus!

It is the Father of Jesus, the Lord Jehovah of Hosts who said, "*Awake, O sword, against My Shepherd, and against the Man who is My Associate, strike the Shepherd...*" The Father Himself issues the command to put to death His intimate Associate, His precious Companion, His Only Begotten beloved Son:; the One whom He has had eternal fellowship with, and through whom He created all things!

Why did the Father do this to His beloved Son? Here is why:

"For **God** <u>so loved</u> the world, that <u>He gave His only begotten Son</u>, so that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; <u>but that the world</u> <u>through Him</u> might be saved. (John 3:16)

\Jesus Himself, during the Last Passover Supper, with His apostles, quoted in part from Zechariah 13:7:

"Then Jesus said unto them, "You will all fall away because of Me this night; for it is written, "<u>*will strike the Shepherd, and the sheep of the flock shall be scattered.*"" (Matthew 26:31)</u>

When the hour of His eternal destiny with the Cross arrived, His human nature said to His intimate Associate, "*Father, if You are willing, remove this cup from Me.*" But then His Devine nature said, "*yet not My will, but Yours be done*." Although the agony in the garden was shared by both the Son and the Father; the Father did not remove the 'cup' of sacrificial death on the cross from His dearly beloved Son. For the joy set before Him, <u>really Them</u>, they both endured the agony in the garden, and the agony of scourging, and agony of the Cross, and the anguish of Separation! For then, for a moment in time eternal, the Father forsook Jesus, and severed His intimate association with His dying Son. And Jesus cried out, "*My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?*" (Matthew 27:46, Psalm 22:1) It is as it says:

"For **He (the Father)** has made **Him (Jesus) to be sin for us**, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him." (2 Corinthians 5:21)

"So Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many; and unto those who look forward to Him, He shall appear the second time without sin, <u>for salvation</u>." (Hebrews 9:28)

Jesus is the Father's close Associate

Jesus is the Father's close and intimate Companion, who was Crucified on the Cross for the forgiveness of our sins!

The Father <u>loved us</u> so very much that He said, "Awake, O sword, against My Shepherd, and against the Man who is My Associate." And Jesus, for the joy of <u>our</u> salvation, endured the Cross and died for <u>our</u> sins!
