Names and Titles and Attributes of Jesus - For Kids

Author of Salvation

"But we do see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, **crowned with glory and honor**; because **He (Jesus)**, by the grace of God has tasted death for every man! For it was fitting **for Him**, for whom are all things, and through whom are all things, in bringing many sons into glory, to make their **Author of Salvation** perfect through sufferings." (see Hebrews 2:3-10)

Author: referring here to a person who is the originator, inventor, creator, pioneer, or founder of something new or unique; and who continues as it's leader and sustainer. Thus, Jesus is the one and only **Author of Salvation** for the complete forgiveness of our sins; for all those people who have faith in Jesus, believing that He died on the Cross to be our Savior from sin.

In context, this title means: **Jesus** is the <u>Originator of Our Salvation</u>, **He** is the <u>Source of Our</u> <u>Salvation</u>, and **He** is the <u>Author of Our Salvation</u>! <u>**He is our Savior**</u> who has saved us from eternal <u>punishment</u> through <u>His death on the Cross</u> for the forgiveness of our sins. And **He**, **Jesus**, <u>continues to be our Savior</u>, and Lord, and King, and Prince of Peace <u>Forever</u>! Apart from Christ Jesus there is No Salvation.

"Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so the **Son of Man (Jesus)** had to be be lifted up (on the cross); so that **whoever believes in Him should not perish**, but <u>have</u> <u>Eternal Life</u>. For <u>God so loved the world</u>, that He gave His Only Begotten <u>Son (Jesus)</u>, so that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have <u>Everlasting Life</u>. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world; <u>but that the world through Him might be saved</u>. He who believes on Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the <u>Name</u> of the Only Begotten Son of God." (see John 3:16-17)

"Although **He (Jesus) was a Son**, He learned, from the things which He suffered: **obedience**; and being perfected, <u>He became for all those who **obey** Him **the Author of Salvation Eternal**</u>." (see Hebrews 5:4-9)

This is what Peter said this about master Jesus, "There is no other Name (Jesus) under heaven, given among men, by which we must be saved." (see Acts 4:12)

"But God, who is rich in mercy, for His Great Love with which He Loved us, even when we were dead in sins, has made us alive together with Christ; by Grace you are Saved! and He has raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus; so that in the ages to come He (the Father) might show the surpassing riches of His Grace in His kindness towards us through Christ Jesus. For by Grace you are Saved through faith; and that not of yourselves. It is the gift of God; and not of works, lest any man should boast. For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God has beforehand ordained that we should walk in them." (see Ephesians 2:4-10)
