Brightness of His Father's Glory

"God (the Father), who at various ways and in diverse manners spoke in times past unto the fathers (ancestors) by the prophets, has in these last days spoken unto us in His Son (Jesus), whom He has appointed Heir of All Things, through whom also He made the ages. Who being **the Brightness of His** (the Father's) **Glory**, and the Exact-representation of His (the Father's) Substance, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins (to forgive and wash away our sins), and sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on High; being made so much better than the angels, as He has by inheritance obtained a more excellent Name than they." (see Hebrews 1:1-4)

Brightness of His Glory: what this means is that all things that show forth the radiance and brightness of the Glory of God the Father: this same bright radiant Glory shines forth through Jesus the Son of God as Jesus does what the Father has sent Jesus to accomplish.

Therefore, Christ Jesus is literally the Radiance and Brightness of God's Glory; and not just a reflection of it. Consider these verses:

"In the beginning was **the Word** (meaning Jesus), and the Word was with God, and **the Word was God**. The **same** (speaking of Jesus) was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him; and without Him was not any thing made that was made. In Him was life; and the life was the Light of men. And the **Light shines** in darkness; and the darkness did not comprehend it. ...And the Word (Jesus) was made flesh (a human being), and lived among us; and we beheld His Glory, the Glory as of the Only Begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth." (see John 1:1-5, 14)

It is God the Father, the Excellent Glory, who has given to His Only Begotten Beloved Son, Jesus, His Love, His Glory, His Honor, and His Majesty. Jesus is **the Brightness of His Fathers Glory!** He is the exact-representation of His Fathers' Nature. If you want to see the Father, **look to Jesus!** As it says:

"For we have not followed cleverly devised fables, when we made known unto you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of His Majesty. **For He received from God the Father Honor and Glory**, when there came such a voice to Him (to Jesus) from the **Excellent Glory (the Father)**, "*This is My Beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.*" And this voice which came from heaven we heard, when we were with Him on the Holy Mountain." (2 Peter 1:16-18)

Jesus wants us to see His Glory! Please consider this prayer of Jesus:

"Father, I also desire that they (the followers of Jesus), whom You have given to Me, be with Me where I am (in Heaven); so that they may **see My Glory, which You have given to Me**; for You loved Me before the foundation (creation) of the world." (John 17:24)
