Jesus Is the Christ Messiah

The word "**Christ**" comes from the Greek word "**Christos**" which means "**Anointed; or the Anointed One**" and is used over five hundred times for Jesus. The word "**Messiah**" is derived from the Hebrew word "**Mashiach**" which also means "**Anointed; or the Anointed One.**" When someone says "Christ Jesus" it is like saying "King Jesus" because Jesus is a King; and He is God's promised **Christ-Messiah**. God has made Jesus **His Anointed Christ-Messiah!** Consider the following:

"There were in the same region shepherds abiding in the field, watching over their flock by night. And, lo, the angel **of the Lord (God)** came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them; and they were very afraid. And the angel said unto them, 'Fear not, for behold, I bring you **Good-news of great joy, which shall be for all people.** For unto you is born this day in the city of David a **Savior (Jesus), who is Christ the Lord.**'" (see Luke 2:8-11)

Jesus, Himself, read from the prophet Isaiah, when He first announced that He was the One anointed by God, with God's Holy Spirit, to be God's promised Christ-Messiah.

"The **Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me; because the LORD (God) has anointed Me** to preach good tidings unto the meek; He has sent Me to bind up the broken-hearted, to proclaim liberty to those who are captive (in sin), and to open the prison to people who are bound (in sin)." (see Isaiah 61:1-3, and Luke 4:18-19)

One day Jesus asked His disciples, saying,

"Who do people say that I the **Son of Man** am?" And they said, "Some say that You are John the Baptist; and some say Elijah; and others say Jeremiah, or one of the prophets." And Jesus said unto them, "But who **do you** say that I am?" And Simon Peter answered and said, "**You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.**" And Jesus answered and said unto him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah; for flesh and blood (people) did not revealed it unto you, **but My Father, who is in heaven, did.**" (see Matthew 16:13-17)

Peter, the close friend and apostle of Jesus said:

"Let all the house of Israel know for sure, that God has made this same Jesus, whom you have crucified, **both Lord and Christ.**" (see Acts 2:29-36)

John the Baptist said this about Jesus:

"For **He (Jesus)** whom God has sent speaks the words of God; for God did not give the Spirit in a limited measure unto Jesus. For the Father loves **(Jesus), and has given all things into His hand.** He who believes on the Son has everlasting life: abut he who does not believe the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abides on him. (see John 3:31-36)

Paul the apostle said this about Jesus:

"It pleased the Father that **in Jesus** should all fulness dwell. ... **For in Jesus dwells all the fulness of Deity** (all the fulness of God) **in human form.**" (see Colossians 1:17-19; and 2:9)
