Jesus is the 'Lamb of God'

""The next day John (the Baptist) saw Jesus coming unto him, and said, '<u>Behold the Lamb of</u> <u>God</u>, who takes away the sin of the world</u>. This is He of whom I said, After me comes a Man who has preference over me: for He existed before me. And I knew Him not: but that He might be manifested to Israel, I therefore came baptizing with water.' And John bore record, saying, 'I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it stayed upon Him. And I knew Him not, but He who sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, 'Upon whom thou shall see the Spirit descending, and remaining on Him, <u>the same is He who baptizes with the Holy Spirit</u>.' And I saw, and bare record that this is the <u>Son</u> of God (the Father)." (see John 1:29-37)

" Surely He has borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows, yet we did esteem Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our sins. <u>The punishment for our peace was upon Him</u>; and with His stripes <u>we are healed</u>. All of us like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD (God) has laid on Him the sin of us all. He was oppressed, and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His mouth. He was brought **as a Lamb** to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is silent, so He did not opened His mouth." (see Isaiah 53: 3-10)

John the Baptist declares Jesus to be the <u>Lamb of God</u> who takes away the sins of the world. In Isaiah chapter 53, Jesus is declared to be <u>the Lamb</u> who was afflicted, smitten, <u>stricken bruised</u>, wounded, <u>slaughtered</u>, and cut of from the land of the living, for <u>our</u> transgressions and sins., Think about these Bible verses:

"...You know that <u>you</u> were not redeemed with corruptible things, such as silver and gold, from your futile way of life received by tradition from your fathers; <u>but by the precious blood</u> <u>of Christ, as of a Lamb without blemish and without spot</u>, Who truly was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you, Who by Him do believe in God, who raised Him up from the dead, and gave Him glory; so that <u>your</u> faith and hope might be in God." (see I Peter 1:18-21)

"And I beheld in the midst of the throne (in Heaven) ... a Lamb standing, <u>as if slain</u>, ... And they sang a new song, saying, 'You (speaking to the Lamb Jesus) are worthy to take the book, and to open the seals; <u>for You (Jesus) were slain, and have redeemed us to God by</u> <u>Your blood</u> out of every kindred, and language, and people, and nation; and have made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.' And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the creatures and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands; saying with a loud voice, '<u>Worthy is the Lamb (Jesus) who was slain</u> to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honor, and glory, and blessing.' And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard them saying, 'Blessing, and honor, and glory, and power, be unto Him who sits upon the throne, **and unto the Lamb** forever and ever.'" (see Revelation 5:6-13)
