

SON of the MOST-HIGH

"And the angel said unto her, 'Fear not, Mary; for you have found favor with God. And, behold, you shall conceive in your womb, and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name Jesus. He shall be great, and shall be called the **Son of the Most-High**; and the Lord God shall give unto Him the throne of His father David; and He shall reign over the house of Jacob forever; and of His kingdom there shall be no end.' Then said Mary unto the angel, 'How shall this be, seeing I know not a man?' And the angel answered and said unto her, 'The Holy Spirit shall come upon you, and the power of the Most-High shall overshadow you; therefore also that Holy-one being born **shall be called the Son of God.**' " (Luke 1:30-32-35)

Son: from the Greek word *huios* meaning: : a son (by birth or adoption), a male descendent, a male offspring, who **shares the same nature as his Father**.

Most-High: from the Greek word *Hypsistou* (*hupsistos*) which means: Highest, or Most-High; masculine singular: in context, the Supreme Being - God! (akin to *hupsi* - on-high; and *hupsos* – height).

This title of Jesus, Son of the Most-High, encompasses and embodies a most supreme title of God the Father, the title **the Most-High**, which is a most high and reverential title of God! This title of the Father is a commonly used title of supreme reverence in the Bible, especially within the Psalms. To help understanding both titles consider these examples:

"I will praise the LORD according to His righteousness; and will sing praise to the Name of Yahweh Most High." (Psalms 7:17)

"Let them be confounded and troubled forever; and let them be put to shame, and perish; so that men may know that **You, whose name alone is Yahweh, are the Most-High over all the earth.**" (Psalm 83:17-18)

"He who dwells in the secret place of **the Most-High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.** I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress; my God; in Him will I trust." (Psalm 91:1-2)

"It is a good thing to give thanks unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto Your name, O Most-High; and to show forth Your lovingkindness in the morning, and Your faithfulness every night," (Psalm 92:1-2)

Most-High: from the Hebrew word *ely wn* which means: Highest, Most-High; noun masculine. Often used as a title for God.

The inclusion of this title of the Father, **the Most-High**, within the title of Jesus – **the Son of the Most-High** – by the angel of God, serves to show the equality and oneness of the Father and the Son. That is Jesus, the Son of God, who shares the same nature as His Father, also shares in the same reverence of the Most High God, the Father! For the Father and the Son are One! Consider also these verses:

"This Jesus has God raised up, of which we are all witnesses. Therefore **being exalted to the right hand of God**, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He has shed forth this, which all of you now see and hear. For David has not ascended into the heavens; but he himself says, '**The Lord said unto my Lord, 'Sit You at My right hand, until I make your enemies your footstool.'**' Therefore let all the House of Israel assuredly know, that God has made this same Jesus, whom you have crucified, **both Lord and Christ.**' (Acts 2:32-36)

“Then Peter and the other apostles answered and said, 'We ought to obey God rather than men. The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom you killed and hanged on a tree. Him (Jesus) **has God exalted** (*hupsoó*: to lift or raise up, to exalt, uplift) with His right hand to be a Prince and a Savior, in order to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins.”

“Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others. Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus; who, **being in the form of God**, thought it not robbery **to be equal with God**; but made Himself of no reputation, and took upon Himself the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men. And being found in fashion as a man, He humbled Himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. Therefore God also has **highly-exalted Him, and given Him a name which is above every name; so that at the Name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth**, and things under the earth; and that every tongue should confess **that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.**” (Philippians 2:4-11)

hyperypsèsen: highly-exalted; to exalt beyond measure; from *hypér*, "beyond" and *hypsó*, "to elevate" – properly, elevate beyond; make exceedingly high, i.e. to a very high degree; to greatly exalt, to extol; to exalt to the highest place; "elevate exceedingly; to exalt to the highest authority and power; to raise to supreme majesty.

As is the Most-High God of all Creation, so is Jesus the Son of the Most-High: both are Highly Exalted! Both have all power and authority in heaven, and over the earth! Consider this final statement from Jesus before His ascension to the Right Hand of the Father:

“Then the eleven disciples went away into Galilee, unto a mountain where Jesus had appointed them. And when they saw Him, **they worshipped Him**; but some doubted. And Jesus came and spoke unto them, saying, 'All power (*exousia*: power to act: authority) is given unto Me in heaven and in earth. Therefore go all of you, and teach all nations, baptizing them **in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit**; teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you. And lo, **I am with you always, even unto the end of the age. Amen.**” (Matthew 28:16-20)
