"No man has seen God at any time. <u>If we love one another, God dwells in us</u>, and His love is perfected in us. Hereby know we that we dwell in Him, and He in us, because <u>He has given us of His Spirit</u>. And we have seen and do testify that <u>the Father sent</u> **the Son** to be the Savior of the world. Whoever shall confess that Jesus is **the Son of God**, God dwells in Him, and He in <u>God</u>. (I John 4:12-<u>14</u>-15)

"And this is the record: that God has given to us eternal life, <u>and this life is in **His Son**</u>. He who has <u>the Son</u> <u>has life</u>; and he who does not have **the Son of God** does not have life." (1 John 5:9-<u>12)</u>

"And the angel said unto her, 'Fear not, Mary; for you have found favor with God. And, behold, you shall conceive in your womb, and bring forth <u>a Son</u>, and shalt call His name **Jesus**. He shall be Great, <u>and shall be called **the Son** of the Highest</u>. And the Lord God shall give unto Him the throne <u>of His father David</u>. And He shall reign over the house of Jacob forever; and of His Kingdom there shall be no end.' " (Luke 1:30-<u>32</u>-33)

Son: from the Greek word *Huion or Huios* (hyiós) which means: a son (by birth or adoption), a male descendent, a male offspring. (figuratively, anyone sharing the same nature as their Father.)

This title of Jesus **'the Son'** is often used as a title unto itself, and will be our focus in this devotional.

This title is also used in combination with several other titles, such as: <u>the Son of the Father</u> (2John 1:3), <u>the Son of the Most-high</u> (Luke 1:32), <u>the Son of the Blessed</u> (Mark 14:61), <u>the Son of Abraham</u> (Matthew 1:1), <u>the Son of David</u> (Matthew 21:9), <u>the Son of Joseph</u> (Luke 3:23), <u>the Only Begotten Son</u> (John 3:15, 18), <u>the Beloved Son</u> (Matthew 17:5), <u>the Firstborn Son</u> (Luke 2:7); and especially, numerous times: <u>the Son of God</u> (John 1:34), and the <u>Son of Man</u> (Matthew 26:64)!

This title is used most often within the context of the relationship between Jesus and the Father in Heaven. Consider these quotes from Jesus Himself:

"Then Jesus answered and said unto them, 'Truly, truly, I say unto you, <u>the Son</u> can do nothing of Himself, <u>except what He sees the Father doing</u>; for whatever things <u>He (the</u> <u>Father</u>) does, these things, likewise, also does <u>the Son</u>. For <u>the Father loves the Son</u>, and shows Him all things that He Himself does; and <u>He (the Father</u>) will show <u>Him (the</u> <u>Son Jesus</u>) greater works than these, that you may marvel. For <u>as the Father</u> raises up the dead, and gives-life to them; even so <u>the Son</u> gives-life to whom He will. For <u>the</u> <u>Father</u> judges no man, but has committed all judgment unto t<u>he Son</u>; so that all men <u>should honor the Son</u>, even as they <u>honor the Father</u>. He who does not honor <u>the Son</u>, does not honor <u>the Father</u> who has sent Him (Jesus). Truly, truly, I say unto you, He who hears My word, and believes on <u>Him (the Father</u>) who sent Me, has everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but has passed from death unto life. Truly, truly, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of <u>the Son</u> <u>of God</u>; and they that hear shall live. For as <u>the Father</u> has Life in Himself; so has He given to <u>the Son</u> to have Life in Himself; and has given Him authority to execute judgment also, because he is <u>the Son of Man</u>. (John 5:19-27)

Jesus said, "All things are delivered to Me by My Father, and no man knows <u>the Son</u>, but the Father; neither knows any man the Father, except <u>the Son</u>, and <u>he (or those people)</u> to whomever **the Son** shall reveal Him" (speaking of the Father). (Matthew 11:27)

and again:

"Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed on Him, '<u>If you continue in My word, then</u> <u>you are My disciples indeed</u>; and you shall know the Truth, and the Truth shall make you free.' But they answered Him, 'We are Abraham's offspring, and were never in bondage to any man; how do You say, 'You shall be made free?' 'And Jesus answered them, 'Truly, truly, I say unto you, whosoever commits sin is the slave of sin. And that slave shall not abide in the house forever; <u>but **the Son** abides forever</u>. Therefore, if <u>**the Son**</u> shall make **you** free, **you** shall be free indeed!' " (John 8:31-35-36)

Our salvation, and our eternal access to the Father, the God of all Creation, is clearly through **the Son**, and only through **the Son**! Please also consider these passages:

Jesus said, "He who believes on <u>the Son</u> has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life; <u>but the wrath of God abides on him</u>." (John 3:36)

"Who is a liar but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ (the Messiah)? He is the antichrist (one who opposes Christ), who denies <u>the Father</u> and <u>the Son</u>. Whoever denies <u>the Son</u>, this one does not have <u>the Father</u>. He who acknowledges <u>the Son has</u> <u>the Father also</u>. Therefore, let that abide in you, which you have heard from the beginning. If that which you have heard from the beginning shall remain in you, you also shall continue in <u>the Son</u>, and in <u>the Father</u>. (I John 2:22-24)

"If we receive the testimony of men, the testimony of God is greater; for this is the testimony of God. that He has testified of **His Son**. He who believes on the **Son of God** has the testimony in himself; he who does not believe God has made Him a liar; because he believes not the testimony that God gave of **His Son**. And this is the testimony, that God has given to us eternal life, and this life is in **His Son**. He who has the **Son** has life; and he who does not have the **Son of God** does not have life." (1 John 5:9-12)

Jesus said, "And this is the will of <u>Him (the Father)</u> who sent Me, that every one who beholds <u>the Son</u>, <u>and believes on Him</u>, may <u>have everlasting life</u>: and I (Jesus) will raise him up at the Last Day." (John 6:40)

JESUS IS ...

"the Son"

The Son of God Most-high, the only begotten Beloved Son of the Father in Heaven!

The Father sent <u>the Son</u> to be the Savior <u>of the world;</u> so that <u>whoever</u> shall confess that Jesus is <u>the Son</u> of God, these shall have eternal life! and God shall dwell in <u>us</u> through His Spirit, whom He shall give to <u>us</u>!

> Truly, truly, t<u>he Son</u> has set <u>us</u> free from the bondage of sin! <u>We</u> are truly made free indeed!
