

Privileges

The following table describes the user role privileges.

Privileges

PRIVILEGE NAME	DESCRIPTION
Change Lab Preferences	<p>This privilege allows you to configure default units and names within projects and tests. Without this privilege, the application disables:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Preferences > Default Names • Preferences > Units > Units Management
Create Diagnostic File	<p>This privilege allows the user to create a diagnostic file, which is used by MTS for diagnostic purposes. Without this privilege, the application disables: Tools > Create Diagnostic Package.</p>
Edit Procedure	<p>This privilege allows the user to define new tests and modify existing tests. Without this privilege, the application changes in several ways:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Project Explorer does not show the Test Definition node under each test. • File > New > Test is disabled. Without this privilege, the only way to create a new test is from a template or existing project. • The application does not show the Toolbox tab. • The application does not show the Properties tab. • The Display menu does not show the Toolbox or Properties items.
Launch the Fatigue Analyzer Application	<p>Start the Fatigue Analyzer application. Without this privilege, the application issues a message when you attempt to open the application.</p>
Launch the Fracture Analyzer Application	<p>Start the Fracture Analyzer application. Without this privilege, the application issues a message when you attempt to open the application.</p>
Launch the Multipurpose Application	<p>Start the Multipurpose application. Without this privilege, the application issues a message when you attempt to open the application.</p>
Launch the Reporter Application	<p>Start the Reporter application. Without this privilege, the application issues a message when you attempt to open the application.</p>
User Management	<p>View information related to users, roles, and privileges. Without this privilege, the application disables Preferences > Settings > User Management.</p>
View Reports	<p>View reports generated by an activity in a test procedure. Without this privilege, the application disables a right-click context menu View Report option.</p>
