

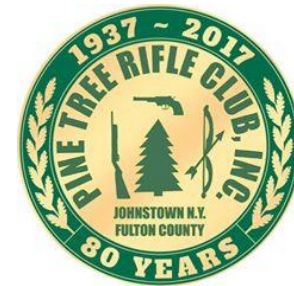

2017 DelSavio Centerfire Series Match Rules

Note: These rules are basically the same as those used in our PTRC Club division matches held during our IBS events. All competition is from the bench – no off-hand shooting. They are not the same exact rules as those used during our Pine Tree Chuck Centerfire Series Fun Shoots.

1. Rifles will be divided into two competitive classes, “Sporter Rifle” and “Benchrest Rifle”

2. Rules Applicable to All Rifles and Equipment Used:

- Shooters will provide a safe and functional rifle and ammunition
- If semi-automatic, must be used with a brass catcher
- Must be less than .36 caliber
- Must not have a muzzle brake
- Any scope magnification is permitted in either class
- Cable-release triggers are not permitted
- Return-to-battery rests are not permitted - one-piece rests are not permitted (butt stock support must be independent from fore-end support)
- Rests cannot be clamped, nailed or otherwise attached to the benches.
- Muzzles must extend beyond the downrange edge of the benches.
- Bolts must be pulled and/or Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI's) must be inserted except between the “Commence Fire” and “Cease-Fire” commands.

3. Sporter Rifle Class:

- Any rifle designed to be shot from the shoulder without additional support:
- Having a convex fore-end not over 3 inches wide
- Not being fitted with flat-bottomed attachments to the fore-end
- Having a working safety
- Not having a tuner
- Weighing no more than 12.5 lbs including sights

4. Benchrest Rifle Class:

- Having a stock designed to contact the shoulder (although free-recoil shooting is permitted)
- Having a flat fore-end no more than 3 inches wide
- Having a fore-end attachment not over 3 inches wide
- Tuners are permitted
- Weighing no more than 16.0 lbs including sights

5. Sporter Rifles may compete in the Benchrest Rifle Class, but Benchrest Rifles may not compete in the Sporter Rifle Class

6. Equipment:

- Shooters may use any formal front and rear rests as long as they are not attached and have a pliable (sand filled) surface including formal front adjustable pedestal rests and/or sandbags. Solid, rigid rests such as metal or wood are not permitted with one exception: Folding bipods similar to the Harris will be permitted.
- Eye and ear protection are required.
- Wind flags may be used.

Tuesday, September 12, 2017

COF: This is a Group Match at both 100 and 200 yards. Relay 1: Shooters will fire five rounds into an IBS 100 Yard Group target at 100 yards with unlimited sighters in 10 minutes. Relay 2: Shooters will fire five rounds into an IBS 200 Yard Group target at 200 yards with unlimited sighters in 10 minutes. Place finishes for both targets are based on the measurement of group sizes with the greater emphasis favoring the smallest group.
