

PTRC Rifleman's Challenge Series

Rules and Procedures

1. Rules applicable to all rifles;

Shooters shall provide;

- a safe and functioning rifle with appropriate ammunition.
- a rifle possessing a functioning safety mechanism.
- a rifle designed to be shot from the shoulder without additional support. Exception: slings will be permitted, however, slings must remain intact with the rifle throughout a relay.
- a rifle using ammunition less than .36 caliber.
- a rifle possessing a convex (rounded) forend not to exceed 2.5 inches in width.
- Muzzle brakes, tuners, and flat-bottomed attachments to the forend are not permitted.
- Rifles cannot weigh more than 12.5 pounds including the sights.
- Bolts and semi-automatic rifle clips/magazines must be pulled at the conclusion of each relay.
- An Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) must be installed in the rifles chamber during a "Cease-Fire."
- The Chief Range Officer will have the final say in the eligibility of a firearm used in these events.

2. Rules applicable to all equipment;

- There is no restriction on scope magnification or the use of a spotting scope.
- Cable release triggers are not permitted.
- No back rest is permitted. Shooters are permitted to support the butt stock using their hands and shoulder.
- Sandbags, blankets, and backpacks, etc. may be used to support the forend of your rifle when shooting from the bench. Bipods are also permitted. No formal, pedestal rest is permitted.
- Rests are not permitted to be attached to the bench.
- Muzzles must extend beyond the down range edge of the bench from both the
- standing and benchrest position.
- Ammo blocks will be provided at the range.
- The Chief Range Officer will have the final say in the eligibility of equipment used in these events.
