

# 2020 Rifleman's X-Treme Challenge

## Course of Fire:

Using a total of 10 rounds, fire a maximum of six (6) rounds to dispatch the three qualifying targets located at 100 yards from the benchrest (sitting) position, then fire the remaining rounds into the Pine Tree Sampson Chuck (green) target located at 25 yards from the off-hand (standing) position in 15 minutes.

## Firearms/Equipment:

Firearms must be of a hunting/sporter classification possessing a convex stock fore end and a functioning safety mechanism. Tuners are not permitted. Firearms may be shared. Front rests may include a bipod, sandbag, backpack or blanket, etc. No rear rests. Shooters may use their hands to support the butt of the stock. Shooters are not permitted to lean against a bench while shooting off-hand (standing). There are no restrictions on telescopic sights. Spotting scopes are permitted as well as quiet coaching. Wind flags are not permitted. A 10-round ammo holder will be provided. An ECI is required for safety purposes. Protective eye wear and hearing protection must also be used. Rifle calibers must be less than .36 caliber. If a firearm malfunction occurs, a shooter may safely borrow another firearm, if available, to finish. The Chief Range Officer will have the final say on eligibility of any firearms or equipment. See official rules for the Rifleman's Challenge Series on the PTRC Website Menu.

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
