



2020 Rifleman's Team Challenge

Course of Fire:

Using a maximum of 10 rounds, fire 5 rounds into the NRA 50 yard target located at 50 yards from the standing (off-hand) position, then fire 5 rounds into the Pine Tree Phil 100 yard target (blue) located at 100 yards from the sitting (benchrest) position in 15 minutes. A shooter must use the same firearm throughout a Relay unless a malfunction occurs. The malfunction must be reported to an RSO first. If approved, the shooter may use another appropriate firearm to finish the Relay.

Firearms/Equipment:

Firearms must be of hunting/sporter classification possessing a convex stock forend and a functioning safety mechanism. Tuners are not permitted. Firearms may be shared. Front rests can include a bipod, sandbag, backpack or blanket, etc. No rear rests. Shooters may use their hands to support the butt of the stock. Shooters are not permitted to lean against a bench while shooting off-hand (standing). There are no restrictions on telescopic sights. Spotting scopes are permitted as well as quiet coaching. Wind flags are not permitted. A 10-round ammo holder will be provided. An ECI is required for safety purposes. Rifle calibers must be less than .36 caliber. Chief Range Officer has final say on eligibility of any firearm or equipment. See official rules for the Rifleman's Challenge Series on the PTRC Website Menu.
