



2020 Rifleman's Strike!

Day/Date: Saturday, October 3, 2020

Location: PTRC Rifle Range

Course of Fire (COF):

This is an experimental 3-D Match featuring 6 bowling pins arranged in a 10" Equilateral Triangular pattern on each Bowling Pin Deck frame. Benches will be drawn on a first come, first served basis. The Chief Range Officer (CRO) will direct shooters to their benches so that they may begin setting-up their firearms and equipment. Each shooter will compete in 5 separate Relays with pauses in between to score and reset the Bowling Pin Decks. Scores will be posted for viewing on the Whaling Wall throughout the morning. During each Relay, shooters will have four (4) minutes to send a maximum of two (2) rounds into their Bowling Pin Deck located at 50 yards.

The CRO will provide a Briefing concerning safety, countdown, Commence-Firing, and Cease-Fire procedures. Shooters are reminded to bring masks and an Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) with them. At the conclusion of the 5 Relays, shooters will be instructed by the CRO as to when they may secure and remove their firearms and equipment. New shooters will then be instructed to set-up at their benches. When the entire match is completed, an Awards Ceremony will take place recognizing the Top-3 place finishers. All shooters will be expected to assist in the breakdown of the target frames and storage of the bowling pins.

Scoring:

Strikes (pins worth 3x)	=	19 points	(18 pts. + 1 pt. Orange pin)
Spares (pins worth 2x)	=	13 points	(12 pts. + 1 pt. Orange pin)
Pins Down	=	0 – 6 points	based on number of pins down
Orange Pins	=	Worth 2 points	except on Strikes and Spares
