Workers should report to the range at 7:00 am. Hand sanitizer will be available on tables near the Range Office, Range Master Station, in the Pavilion, and in the range Porta-Potty. Bring a mask.

Registration will be held under the Pavilion located near the parking lot as you enter the club grounds. Be attentive to the three stations provided when entering the registration area. You will first report to the financial Officer: Ed Anker. Next you will move to Anne Haggerty to purchase a meal ticket (or not), and finally move to the Registrar: Ken Benton. From there, you will drive down to the range and secure your bench assignment with the Chief Range Officer: Mike Johnson. Mike will be assisted with RSO's Tom Fernandez, Anne Haggerty, and Ken Benton during the event.

Please be attentive to the areas on the range marked Mask Zones. The Zones are identified by white and orange colored boxes that coincide with areas surrounding range buildings. Physical Distancing lines along the Wailing (Target) Wall are also marked so that you can safely and thoughtfully inspect your posted targets. Everyone must be wearing a mask while in those Zones. It is also important to restrict physical contact while on the range. This is important – we need to do this right if we plan to continue offering opportunities related to the shooting sports.

Odd numbered benches 11-39 will only be occupied by Relay 1 shooters. Even numbered benches will only be occupied by Relay 2 shooters. As part of our Best Health Protocols, there will be no sharing of benches this season. Benches 1-9 along with tables near the Range Office are also available for cleaning. Please use the hand sanitizer that is available.

Target Crews, led by Wayne VanDetta and Peter Betz, will be continuously on the go retrieving and posting targets, running them up to the Scoring Shack, then returning them to the range and posting the targets on the Wailing Wall. Again, be attentive to the Mask Zones. The Scoring Committee includes Harold Miller and Bill Tyler. The targets are provided by our target Coordinator: Anne Haggerty.

The 2-Stage Luncheon will also require you to wear masks under the Pavilion until you are ready to eat. Present your meal ticket upon arrival to the Pavilion. Be sure to use the hand sanitizer that is made available. Cold water bottles will be available under the Pavilion as well as in the Range Master Station.

The Awards Ceremony will take place under the Pavilion as in previous years. Masks must be worn and Physical Distancing will be enforced. Everyone must wear a mask for group photos. A shooter may remove their mask for individual photos. No alcoholic beverages are permitted under the Pavilion at this time.
