## Welcome to the 2018 PTRC Schützenfest

**Day/Date:** Saturday, September 29, 2018  
**Site:** Pine Tree Rifle Club  
**Registration:** 7:30 AM      **Briefing:** 8:30 AM      **Relays Begin:** 9:00 AM  
**Entry Fee:** \$ 25.00 (Maximum of 5 Buy-Ins @ \$1.00 Each)  
**Awards:** Medals & Mugs: Top 3 Place Finishers  
**Lunch:** Included with registration (following last relay)

**Course of Fire:** For each relay, shooter will fire a maximum of three (3) rounds into the NRA 100 Yard paper target located at 100 yards from the standing (off-hand) position in five (5) minutes. NEW AND CHALLENGING!

**Match Rules:** Shooters must use a hunting style rifle that is no larger than .36 caliber. Each rifle must include a working safety. Shooters may use a sling, but may not lean against a bench for support. Muzzle brakes are not permitted. There are no restrictions on telescopic sights. Range officials have final say on the eligibility of any firearm or equipment used in this event. Best target for each individual for the day will establish place finish with tie-breaker criteria applied.

## Place Finish Criteria:

Shooters have the opportunity to fire on a total of six (6) targets which includes the buy-ins. Only the target with the highest score and x-count for each shooter will apply towards a place finish.

- 1) Shooter with the highest target score for the event is declared Schützenkönig (Champion).
- 2) Shooter with the second highest target score for the event is declared 2<sup>nd</sup> Place Finisher.
- 3) Shooter with the 3<sup>rd</sup> highest target score for the event is declared 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Finisher.

## Tie-Breaker Criteria:

Should a tie occur within the group (cohort) of shooters eligible for Top-3 place finishes based on score, the following tie-breaker criteria shall be applied:

- 4) Greatest number of X's
- 5) Greater number of 10's
- 6) Greater number of 9's
- 7) Greater number of 8's
- Greater number of 7's
- 8) Greater number of 6's
- 9) Greatest number of 5's
- 10) Shoot Off: One shot at 100 yards – closest to center in two (2) minutes.

Benches 8, 11, 14, 17, 20, 23, 26, and 29 will be utilized for this event.
