

Registration Form for the NRA RANGE SAFETY OFFICER COURSE

This course teaches the basic duties that a Range Safety Officer performs. It provides a thorough introduction to the role of Range Safety Officers (RSOs); range Standard Operating Procedures (SOP); range safety briefings; range inspections and rules; emergency procedures; and how to clear firearm stoppages and to correct malfunctions. The skills acquired in this course require regular practice which should initially take place under the supervision of a qualified individual - such as an NRA Chief Range Safety Officer (CRSO).

This course of study is being offered Sunday May 5th, 2019 8AM-5PM. The course length may vary depending on the instructor/student's ratio and the participant's abilities. Program location will be the Pine Tree Rifle Club's upper level. The number of participants is **limited!**
