- Relays:** There will be three 3 Relays this season. Relays 1 and 3 will utilize all odd numbered benches with the exception of Bench 39. Bench 39 will not be used this season. Relay 2 will utilize all even numbered benches. Members may only register for one class this season due to availability of benches and social distancing. - Bench Selection:** Members may request a specific Relay and starting Bench on their registration form. Understand that some families will need to stay close to each other due to youth supervision or sharing equipment. Every effort will be made to satisfy your request. If the Bench you chose is already occupied, you will be assigned the next Bench in succession. You may also simply request another Bench. Contact: Ed Anker
- Bench Rotation:** Bench rotation will continue to be six (6) Benches per week. A schedule has already been developed and copies will be posted on the Range Master Station and Range Office. A personal copy may also be provided for each member.
- Registration Fee:** Members may make their RFL Registration Fee payment of \$50.00 by check and made out to the Pine Tree Rifle Club. Checks may be mailed with their registration form or delivered by hand when they arrive at the range. Cash is also acceptable at the range. The Registration Fee should be paid within three (3) weeks from the time dated on the Registration Form. All Registration payments should be directed to Ed Anker or Anne Haggerty.
