"Believe" – John 3:14-16 & Numbers 21

- 1) What is the significance of the snake on the pole scenery as talked about by Jesus to Nicodemus? (John 3:14-15 & Numbers 21)
- 2) In Numbers 21, the Israelites were grumbling against Moses once again – believing that the progress and process into the Promised Land was ridiculous. In what way, or ways, are you presently grumbling – believing that the way into the Promised Land, heaven, is ridiculous?
- 3) How does your belief manifest itself out in actions? For instance, the truth is that Christ is the only way for salvation, but how do your actions actually betray your belief in such truth - revealing that you seemingly believe otherwise?
- 4) If you were to write the Webster's Dictionary description for the word "belief," what would you share? Give practical, daily, examples of "believing".
- 5) When you believe in Jesus Christ, what do you receive? What is the promise of Jesus for all who would believe in Him? Why would a person believe in anyone other than Jesus Christ? How would you share your belief in Jesus Christ to a non-believer? What is your testimony of belief?
- 6) What exactly is it about Jesus Christ that captivates your heart to believe in Him?
- 7) What would it take for you to have more belief in Christ? What is Christ calling you to believe more in (what is the next step, a step you may be wrestling with, in your "belief walk" with God?) What/How will you step out and take action on that belief?
