Read 1 John 1:8-2:2

1. Have you ever deceived yourself? What were the returns?
2. Why would God’s Word have no place in your life right now?  
Is there a sin blocking the entrance of His Word into your life?
3. Respond to the comment “Sin can keep you from God’s Word or God’s Word can keep you from sin.”
4. How does one experience God’s faithfulness when one confesses sin?
5. How does one experience God’s justice when one confesses sin?
6. What does it mean to you that God promises to forgive a sin confessor?
7. What does it mean to you that God promises to purify a sin confessor?
8. So what if you sin? What/Who is the provision for getting right with God?
9. What does it mean to you that Jesus Christ is speaking to the Father in your defense? What do you think, exactly, Jesus Christ is saying to the Father in your defense?
10. What does it mean to you that Jesus is the Righteous One?
11. What does it mean to you that Jesus is the Atoning Sacrifice for sin(s)?
12. What is your response to God for Jesus having the ability to take away ALL unrighteousness, or for Jesus being the sacrifice for the sins of the WHOLE world? Isn’t about time to give some thanks to the One and only Savior of our souls? Give Thanks!
