

**Personal/Group Study Guide Week of  
Dec 9, 2007**

**Just 1  
“Leading One”**

Last week our JUST 1 series was kicked-off by the challenge to “NOTICE ONE” people. We asked to have our radar up for those around us who we can reach. This week, we learned that we can lead people to salvation in Christ through a simple conversation. As you read these verses below and reflect on the questions, ask how God might use you to lead someone to Him.

Do you remember when you first accepted Christ into your life? Briefly write the highlights of that story and share it with someone today.

Have you ever led someone to faith in Jesus Christ? If so, share the experience with someone else. If not, what has held you back from engaging in conversations that could lead someone to Christ? How can you overcome those fears?

Romans 3:23 says that we are all sinful. If we all generally acknowledge that we struggle with sin, what do you think prevents people from seeking a remedy for sin?

Read Isaiah 59:2 and come to some conclusions as to what “separation from God” is all about. Romans 6:23 says that while our sins lead to death, God freely offers us new life through Christ. This undeserved gift is what we call grace. Do you ever have a hard time accepting that God could offer such grace? Why do you think that “grace” is such a radical idea for us humans?

Romans 10:9-10 tells us how we can receive salvation in Christ. After reading this passage, how is a person saved? Why do you tend to think we make it a lot more complicated than it really is? In preparation for Christmas, also read Matthew 1:18-25. What is the significance for you and everyone of the names “Jesus” and “Immanuel”?

Read Matthew 4:19 As a Christ-follower, would you say you view yourself as a “fisher of people”? What would it look like in your day to day life to truly become a “fisher of people”?

Read Luke 15:7 What does this mean to you regarding giving someone an invitation to “Letter at Christmas”? Spend the next few moments talking about and praying about who you are planning on inviting to Rejoice!’s first Christmas production. Read 1Peter 3:15 What steps have you taken and will you be taking towards making an invite?

Over the next week, commit to memorizing Romans 3:23, 6:23 & 10:9-10. As you do so, ask God to give you the courage and willingness to share this Good News with others.
