

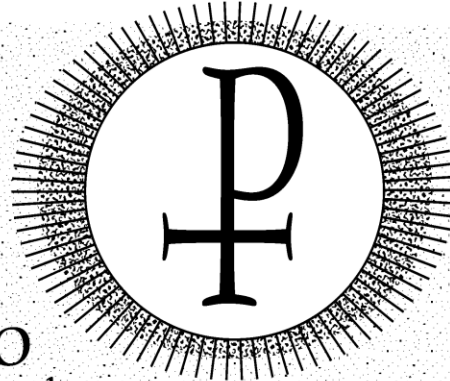
The Ascension of the Lord

Mass Times...

As you will recall, on the weekend of February 13th and 14th I announced that a decision has been made to keep the current Mass schedule and that the parish councils have been notified of this. Please refer to that bulletin column if you wish. It can be found on the parish website in the bulletin section under: Sixth Sunday of Ordinary Time. I also said in that column that another adjustment to the Mass schedule could happen and would be announced before the end of June. It is now the month of June and I do have an announcement in regard to the current Mass times.

Given the complexity of the four parish cluster and the dynamic of the reality in which we live, discussion with parish pastoral councils on the matter of Mass times has been slow and steady. I would like to continue on with this slow and steady pace and not make any adjustments to the Mass times until the end of September. At which time any adjustments made would likely be minor. This gives us time to allow what we have now for Mass times to have been in place for almost a full year.

In the meantime, I want you all to know of the appreciation I have for you in working with me. I can see that this has not been easy on some of you. I want to remind others that it is not always the loudest squeal or the angriest look that gets consideration. We have a real issue here with this four parish cluster and we need to face that issue ourselves. The issue is that we only have one priest for four parishes that are quite different in their needs. I want you to know that I give you all that I have. I see that you give me your best too. We have such wonderful liturgies, faith formation activities and parish gatherings here in our four parishes. But it does get difficult sometimes, for me and for you. Sometimes I feel like I am being punished for answering the call to the priesthood, and I know that is not that case. I think sometimes some of you feel like you are being short changed or that your parishes are not important. Your parishes are important. You are very important. I think so much of all of you, and even though my time here has not been an easy experience, I would not change it for anything.
