

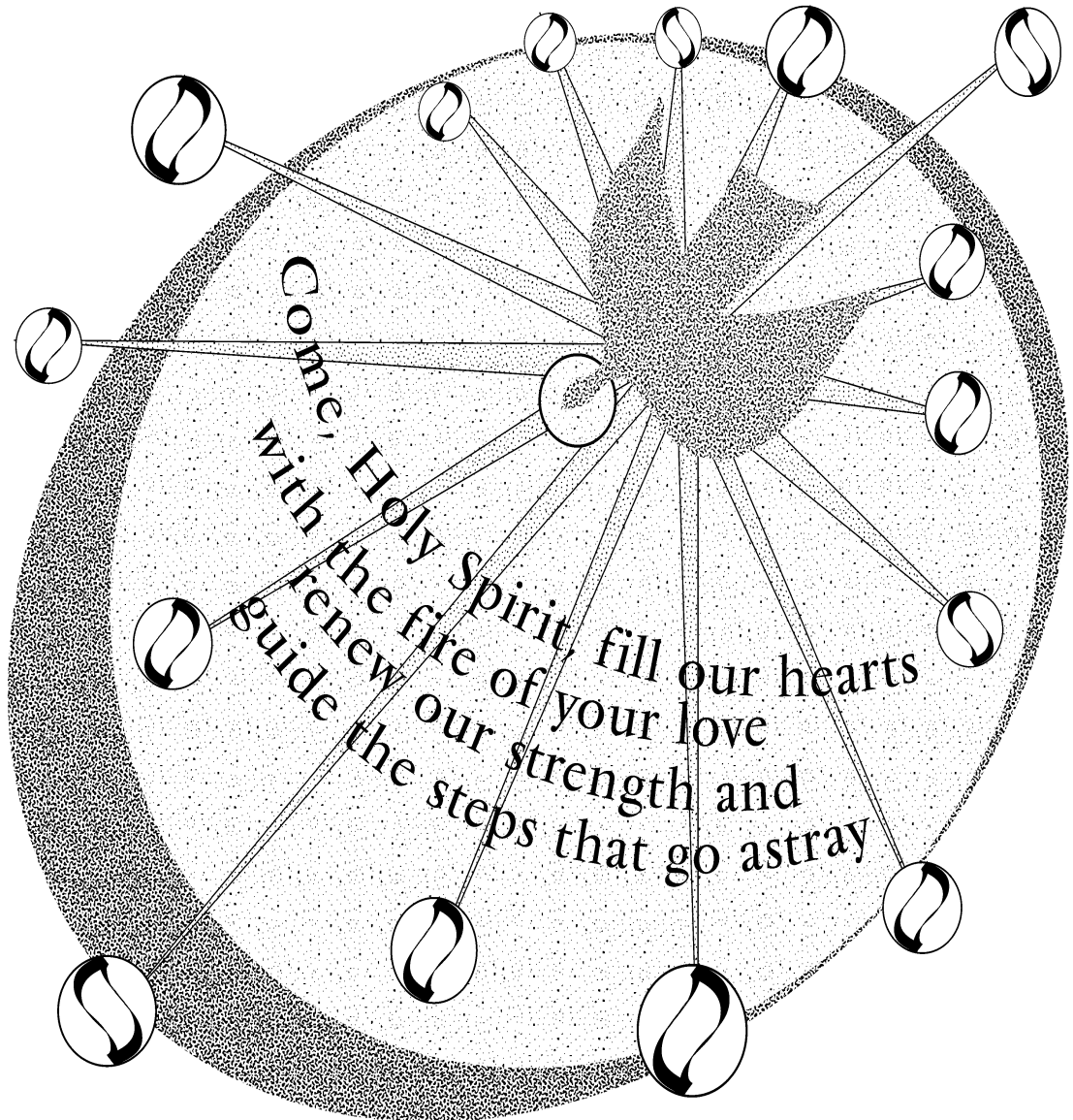
**Pentecost Sunday

Respect Life - While movies, television, and peers told them otherwise, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, as of 2009, over 72% of girls and over 71% of boys age 15 to 17 have remained abstinent. Including all teenagers ages 15 to 19 in the 2006-2008 reporting period, nearly 58% have remained abstinent. If they can resist pressure from movies, television, and peers to become sexually active, why can't the others? Of the teens who are sexually active, great majority of sexually-active teens use contraception, but one in three sexually-active teen girls will become pregnant within two years, and half of the 20 million new cases of STDs each year are acquired by young people. - USCCB web site, June 2011.

Graced Movements!

Today, the glorious season of Easter comes to a conclusion as we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost. Our scriptures focus on the coming of the Holy Spirit to the apostles and with this gift, the Church is born. Through our baptism, we too have been given the gift of the Spirit. The Holy Spirit (*the fire which burns in our hearts and the breath of wind that blows us in new directions*) is the force that can lift burdens, dry tears, heal broken lives, impart forgiveness and do great works of charity. The Holy Spirit is a very

powerful force in the lives of Christians but only if we are willing to open our hearts to this wonderful gift!

Have you every listened to yourself pray the creed - especially the words: *I believe in the Holy Spirit?* Basically, when we say these words, we acknowledge that "we believe there is a living God able and willing to enter human personality and change it" (J.B. Phillips). Sometimes I think that we are afraid to examine the workings of the Holy Spirit in our lives. Perhaps we might hear us being 'called' to a new way of living. Let me share a piece written by Corrie Ten Boom: *I have a glove here in my hand. The glove cannot do anything by itself, but when my hand is in it, it can do many things. True, it is not the glove, but my hand in the glove that acts. We are gloves. It is the Holy Spirit in us who is the hand, who does the job. We have to make room for the hand so that every finger is filled. The question on Pentecost is not whether God is blessing our own plans and programs but whether we are open to the great opportunities to which [God's] Spirit calls us.*

It is so easy to miss the graced movement of God in our lives – especially when we are so busy. However, that doesn't mean God is absent. Have you ever experienced a rush of peace or love in your heart? Have you ever felt God's tangible support? These too are examples of the graced movement of God in our lives. In both Hebrew and Greek, the word that is used for *breath* is the same word that is used for *spirit*. In these troubling times, I invite each of us to take a deep breath and blow out anything that keeps you from receiving God's gift. Take a deep breath and pray with me:

Come, Holy Spirit: *Replace the tension within us with a holy relaxation. Replace the turbulence within us with a sacred calm. Replace the anxiety with a quiet confidence. Replace the fear with a strong faith. Replace the bitterness within us with the sweetness of grace. Replace the darkness with a gentle light. Replace the coldness with loving warmth. Replace the night with Your day. Replace the winter with Your spring.*

Straighten our crookedness, fill our emptiness. Dull the edge of our pride, sharpen the edge of our humility. Light the fires of our love, quench the flames of our lust. Let us see ourselves as You see us, that we may see You as You have promised, and be fortunate according to Your word. Blessed are the pure of heart- for they shall see God.
