
Sixth Sunday of Easter May 13, 2012

Respect Life –Happy Mother's Day! Two pro-life bills are currently making their way through the Minnesota Legislature. Both are strongly supported by *Minnesota Citizens Concerned for Life* (MCCL), and would require licensure of abortion facilities and ban "webcam abortions" in which the RU486 abortion drug is given to pregnant women without a doctor being physically present. Call your Representative at 651-296-2146 and your Senator at 651-296-0504 to urge them to vote to ban "webcam abortions" and to pass the abortion center licensing and inspections bill.
