
Third Sunday of Lent March 11, 2012

Lent and Abortion...

I had the distinct honor to preside at the Mass for installation of new members of the Catholic Daughters of the Americas on Tuesday at Our Lady of Good Counsel Parish. The homily I delivered touched mainly on the importance of charity and how from charity stems unity. The motto of the CDA is "unity and charity" you see. At one point in my preaching I offered the point of fact that it is in helping the poor and suffering where we achieve the greatest degree of unity with our neighbor, our God and our very selves.

I must apologize now for a gross error in my preaching. In an attempt offer an example of how helping those who are vulnerable leads to greater joy in our lives I gave an example of families who raise children with Down's syndrome. They experience a greater degree of cohesiveness in their marriage and their family: they know firsthand the strong bond which stems from charity. In a tangential note in my homily, I mentioned that today 80% of babies diagnosed with Down's syndrome while still in the womb are aborted. This was my error. The correct statistic is that 90% of mothers who suspect that the child in their womb has Down's syndrome choose to have the pregnancy terminated by way of abortion. I will get my facts right next time.

The traditional practice of "giving something up for Lent" is a practice of self-denial; our Lord said that to follow him, we must deny our very selves. It means we say No to ourselves and Yes to God and others. This reverses the pattern of sin, which says Yes to ourselves and No to God and others. In our culture, the most violent No to God and others is abortion. Four thousand times every day in our nation, people say No to a little child so that they may say Yes to their fears or their plans. This Lent, as we practice self-denial, let's think of these children. Let's offer our sacrifices for them. May all say Yes to God and Yes to the unborn.
