


passion and the suffering of our Lord. This year the passion of our Lord comes from the Gospel according to St. Matthew. Out of the three evangelists, St. Matthew is the only evangelist who at the last supper puts in Jesus' lips that his cup is offered for the forgiveness of sins, "this is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed on behalf of many for the forgiveness of sins." Forgiveness or reconciliation is the central theme in St. Matthew's Gospel; there are many stories throughout this Gospel where Jesus calls his disciples to be a forgiving and reconciling community. As we enter Holy Week and celebrate together the Easter Triduum, we are also called to seek out God's forgiveness and reconciliation with God and with one another. Let us become a forgiving and reconciling community!



FROM FATHER STAN

Welcome to Holy Week! We begin with Passion (Palm) Sunday today, where the gospel concludes with the burial of Jesus after his crucifixion. The readings during the weekday Masses feature the Songs of the Suffering Servant from Isaiah, and the gospels are the anointing of Jesus



in preparation for his funeral, foretelling the betrayal of Judas, and denial of Peter. Then we are into the Triduum, (Latin for "three days") that constitute a single liturgical service that encompasses all the most important things we do. Holy Thursday we focus on service and the Eucharist. There is no dismissal, so we continue the next day with Good Friday – which does not being with a greeting. Good Friday we read the Passion Narrative from the gospel according to John, prayer intensive intercessions, and venerate the cross. Good Friday is the one day in the year where Mass is not celebrated. Again there is no dismissal, and on Saturday night we enter into the Easter Vigil. That most important liturgy of the year begins in darkness, then a fire is lit and a candle is inscribed with the year and lit. Light is passed throughout the church, and we settle into a number of readings about God's saving acts throughout history. Eventually we sing a Gloria, and shortly after we hear the Easter gospel proclaimed. On this night new members are baptized if they have not been before. Everyone else renews their baptismal vows. Others are received into the Church, and Confirmed. And, of course Mass is celebrated. There is a dismissal at the end of this service. The Triduum ends on Sunday at Sunday, after the celebration of the various Easter Masses.

In the earliest days of the Church, the community gathered on Sundays to celebrate the resurrection of the Lord. As almost all of them were Jewish, they projected that on to the annual celebration of Passover as well, both because of the implications of being saved from death and slavery to sin, as well as the time of year of the crucifixion and resurrection. Each Sunday was seen as so critical of a celebration (a little Easter each week, if you will) that it wasn't until after the year 100 that there was a specifically Christian celebration of Easter. Even then the Church in Rome waited until the second half of the second century to accept it. Moreover, for years there were two ways of calculating the date for the celebration of Easter: should it be on Passover, or the following Sunday? Furthermore, should they use a lunar calendar or a solar calendar should it be in some way connected to the Jewish feast

of Passover, or on the Sunday closest to the actual day of the resurrection, which is disputed. We know Jesus died on Friday of the week of Passover, but what year? He rose the following Sunday morning. According to (now Cardinal) Walter Kasper, the best evidence says April 7th, 30 A.D. I don't have room to go into a long discussion of the development of the Triduum; suffice it to say it is a very ancient practice.

My friend has never heard of Christ and I want to share the Gospel with her but I'm afraid to. How do I share my faith?



There are a lot of ways to bring up the topic of religion, without being judgmental or pushy. Begin by asking what her thoughts are about religion, or what her experience was growing up. Finding common ground is often easier than you think, because the questions and problems we have about God, the presence of evil, our purpose in life, and our relationship with God are universal concerns.

Why are you afraid? If you do not want to insult or offend someone, don't be pushy or judgmental. If you are uncertain about how to explain your own faith, do a little reading or practice with a friend. If you measure success only by this person converting, focus your attention more on beginning the conversation, not on bringing it to a perfect close! Faith is a journey of many acts of belief, many discussions about God, and many choices about how we practice what we preach. In some we will have great success; in others we will need forgiveness and perseverance. The most important thing to keep in mind is that the Holy Spirit is always at work and our most humble efforts can bear great fruit. Have faith in God because he has faith in you!




